NBCA Long Service Medals are for band members and/or musicians who have served at least 25 years with bands <u>affiliated</u> with a state governing body and therefore the National Band Council of Australia Inc. This includes service with bands that no longer operate but were affiliated during their existence.

Service with a Military Service band (i.e. Australian Army, Navy or Air Force), or the Salvation Army, for example, does not count towards this medal.

The medal is a fine way to pay tribute to esteemed and long serving members/musicians (the presentation of which could enhance your annual dinner program). The cost of each medal is \$25.00. Written nominations for the medal should include a brief banding history of the nominee. Please forward any written nominations on this form to the Secretary of your state governing body, with a cheque made payable to the (name of the state governing body).
