

Rule 23b. . . . A Soloist winning a competition shall not after a period of twenty eight (28) days play the same music at any Contest as own choice until after the expiration of two years after the commencing date of the said contest. . .

The following paragraph has been deleted. This will not apply to a Junior competitor in a junior competition.

- 23(e) A competitor may compete once only in duets, trios, quartettes, and septettes, and on only one instrument in solo work, and in any section such instrument must be the one he plays in his Band.
- 23(j) Delete the words "Except Juniors" in line two and three.
- 23(k) Competitors in Party Competitions shall consist only of the registered members of the same Band.
- 23(m) In all age groups age shall be as at the date of Competition.

Your co-operation in making this competition a success is requested by not leaving or entering the hall while a competitor is playing.

The entries for this competition make it essential that we have "NO DELAYS" between items. Competitors therefore are requested to be ready to play immediately the previous player is finished.

Remember - A MINUTE SAVED IS A MINUTE GAINED.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS -

1. All Rules of the Australian Band Council and Band Association of New South Wales will apply throughout these Competitions, also Special Rules set by the Contest Committee as supplied herewith.
2. The Competitions will be under the control of the Contest Committee and the Delegate/s. Any breach of the Rules or Conditions may subject the Competitor to Disqualification and/or fine.
3. If less than three (3) entries in any section the Committee reserves the right to delete this section or combine it with any other section.
4. All Solo and Party Competitors must be present at the same time for drawing for places, ready to go straight on the stage, after drawing Competitors must proceed as instructed, or they may be disqualified and not allowed to compete. Sections will not be held over for competitors who are not present when section is timed to commence.
5. **COMPETITORS MAY BE RUNG OFF BY THE JUDGE AT ANY TIME.**
6. All music for these competitions is Own Choice, except State Championships. No Competitor shall play as own choice any solo being used as a TEST SOLO in any other section.
7. Competitors **WILL NOT** be allowed to play trumpets in any section of the Competition.

8. Competitors in the Junior sections may compete in higher age group.
9. All Competitors in Junior sections may be required to produce their Birth Certificates, or proof of age prior to the commencement of their Sections; or at any time during the Competitions.
10. Adjudicator/s will be screened off.
11. Music for the use of the Adjudicator must be in the hands of the Contest Delegate 15 minutes prior to the commencement of the SOLO Section in which they are to compete.

BARS OF MUSIC MUST BE NUMBERED.

12. A Competitor may compete once only in Duets and Quartettes, and such instrument shall be the one he plays in his Band.
 13. All Duet and Quartette parties must consist of Members of the same Band.
 14. Competitors will be allowed the services of their Bandmaster or a member of their Band to conduct them in Quartette Sections.
- ALL MEMBERS AND CONDUCTOR MUST BE IN UNIFORM**
15. Accompanist will be allowed for Solo and Duet Competitors.
 16. Copies of Music will be required for the Adjudicator, Accompanist and Yourself. Please secure your music at the conclusion of your section as **NO RESPONSIBILITY WILL BE ACCEPTED** for music not collected.
 17. Only the names and points of the three highest placed competitors in each section may be announced. All other comments may be obtained from the Committee Room.
 18. It is compulsory for the winner of each State Championship Section to compete in the Champion of Champions Section. Failure to do so may result in the prize for that section being awarded to the competitor placed second. Competitor must not play the same solo played in winning his section. This rule will be strictly adhered to.

Mrs. HELEN TAYLOR

The daughter of one of Australia's immortal conductors, namely, MASSA JOHNSON of Melbourne Fire Brigade Band fame of the 30's, Mrs. Taylor was brought up in the Brass Band world.

Helen was arranging and writing for brass bands at the age of 12 years. After studying under Mr. Percy Jones, her first composition was published when she was only 16. Among Mrs. Taylor's best-known compositions is the test solo "Anna Karenina".

Very prominent in the field of banding in Victoria, our guest has adjudicated at many contests.

When requested by the Band Association of New South Wales to compose a Solo to be used as Test for Cornet and Euphonium sections at the 1970 Australian Championship Solo Competitions, Mrs Taylor readily agreed and the result of this agreement will be seen and heard at these Competitions.

We welcome Mrs Taylor once again to Arncliffe as Adjudicator and we await with interest her remarks this weekend.


