



NOTICES AND INSTRUCTIONS

This Contest is held under the auspices of the Queensland Band Association and rules of the National Band Council and the Q.B.A. will apply throughout.

Bands must compete in all sections for which they have entered on the official programme.

All marching contests are compulsory.

Each Band Secretary shall collect the personal signature of each competitor on the form provided before each item at the Contest. These forms must be completed and returned to the Queensland Band Association officials before the Band may compete.

Secretaries and Conductors of Bands must observe perfect punctuality in assembling to draw for positions at times and places appointed and in placing their Bands upon the contest stage.

Each Band in its numbered order must be ready to march on before the preceding one has left the stage. Each Band, after leaving the stage, must play an item as next Band gets ready if required. The Band drawing last place will play the first Band on to the stage, the first Band will play on the second, and so on in their rotation.

The Contest Delegates reserve the right to require the competing Bands to take part in any street marching or playing they may deem desirable.

Any Band late at the drawing, or not ready to proceed with the Contest as directed by the Q.B.A. Officials, is liable to a fine or disqualification. The Delegates of the Q.B.A. have sole control of the music portion of the Contest, and all their directions must be carefully and promptly complied with.

The representatives of all of the Bands from whom places are to be drawn must present themselves at the time and place for such drawing. Any Band not present at the time appointed may not be eligible to compete. Defaulters may be fined.

Bands must be placed on stage according to formation adopted by the Australian Band Council.

All competitors must be properly dressed.

No Band shall engage in any counter attraction at the Contest without the consent of the Committee.

Winners of any event must repeat their item if called upon to do so by the Delegates.

All items will be taken in order as arranged in this programme, unless otherwise notified, but the Contest Delegates reserve the right to alter or amend the programme as required by circumstances.

Any courtesy items played during the Contest, whether at Street Marching, playing Bands on or off the platform, or at Inspection, shall not include any item that has been or will be played in a competitive number in such Contest.

All Bands must be in possession of the PALINGS HYMN SHEET and Massed Marches as selected.

Music in Diagram March and Street March will be "own choice". Bands must provide Music with Bars marked at the drawing for positions. Solo Cornet parts may be accepted for the Street March.

Competitors must conform to the commencing times as appearing in the programme.

The Adjudicator's awards for solo and party competitions will be announced as decided by the Contest Delegates. Band awards will be announced at the end of each session.

No person (other than officials) will be allowed on or about the stage during the competition.

Bands must play a minimum of two (2) verses in each hymn tune.

Each Band will be required to supply a copy of their OWN CHOICE MUSIC.

SOLO AND PARTY COMPETITORS: Any competitor in solo and party competition arriving after drawing for positions has commenced will not be allowed to compete. Competitors must play in the position drawn.

No emergency players shall be allowed in any party item.

All music which is own choice in both solo and party competitions shall be restricted to a maximum of five minutes duration. Contest Delegates reserve the right to further reduce this maximum if they deem it necessary.

Soloists and parties playing own choice music must provide a copy for the Judge, otherwise they will not be allowed to compete. All music bars must be numbered.

In any event where age qualifications applies, birth certificates must be produced to Contest Delegates on demand.

When a solo item is in progress, only the competitor in that particular item will be allowed on the stage. Solo competitors will not be allowed on the stage while the preceding item is in progress or until they are called for the purpose of drawing for places in the item in which they will compete.

Competitors may tune their instruments with the piano prior to the commencement of each respective competition. Tuning will not be permitted during a competition.

After tuning, competitors must remain where directed until called to the stage to perform.

In Junior items, competitors must be under the stated age at the date of competition.

Competitors are reminded that in each competitive item they will be judged on Department.

NOTE.—Test Music cannot be played as own choice music.

Caps shall not be worn when playing indoors.

Drum Majors shall wear Caps at all times.

NOTE: The drawing for the Street March will take place at Q.B.A. office, City Hall, Maryborough, at 3.00 p.m. Friday afternoon, 9th April.

Representatives must be in possession of the Music for the Judge with Bars numbered.

NOTE: The drawing for the Diagram March will take place at the Q.B.A. office, City Hall, Maryborough at 2.30 p.m. Saturday afternoon, 10th April.

Representatives must be in possession of Music for the Judge with Bars numbered.

Assembly point for Street March: Corner of Richmond and Kent Streets at the Bungalow Theatre.

Drum Majors are requested to move their Bands both OFF and ON Stage when instructed to do so to avoid unnecessary waiting for Bands that follow.

NOTE: Bands must compete at the times outlined in the programme.

INSPECTION: Bands will be inspected as indicated in this programme.





ALEX H. HENDERSON – Music Adjudicator

*Deputy Director of Music, Australian Military Forces,
Canberra.*

Commenced banding at the age of 10 years, was Solo Cornet in the Geelong City Band for seven years under the late Mr. Percy Jones, six years as Tenor Horn in the Brisbane Excelsior Band under Jas. Compton, three years as 1st Trombone with the No. 1 Band at the Royal Military School of Music (Kneller Hall). During this period he participated in many occasions of State as Kneller Hall Trumpeter, one occasion being the Wedding of Princess Margaret at Westminster.

He received the Diploma of Bandmaster of the Bandsmen's College of Music, England, 1957. Diploma of Associate of the Royal College of Music (London) for Military Bandmastership, graduated Kneller Hall as Bandmaster in 1962. Appointments as Bandmaster include Frankston Silver Band, Footscray Yarraville Band, Central Command Band, Adelaide and Eastern Command Band, Sydney.

From 1962 to 1964 he has adjudicated in New South Wales, Victoria and Tasmania. Since then he was obliged to decline adjudication due to Army obligations.

C. F. SORRELL – Drill Adjudicator

Adelaide, South Australia.



Mr. Sorrell commenced his banding career with the Sturt Street (Adelaide) School Band, which was very successful in School Bands competitions.

After his school days he took over the role of Drum Major and has led many South Australian Bands with considerable success, including Prospect City, Glenelg Citizens, Mount Gambier Citizens and Henley & Grange Bands.

He has coached many South Australian Bands for competitions in both South Australia and Ballarat, Victoria.

In 1961, he was associated with the instruction of the first Drum Majors School which is now an Annual Course in South Australia.

For the last ten years he has been registered as a Drill Adjudicator with the South Australian Band Association and during that time has adjudicated in many South Australian centres, including Australian Championships at Adelaide and Ballarat, Victoria.

Mr. Sorrell is President of the South Australian Band Association and also the Bands Marching Girls' Association for which he is Chief Judge.

Mr. Sorrell was appointed Director of the Adelaide Festival of Arts Procession and was responsible for the planning and organisation of this important event in 1964, 1966, 1968 and 1970.

In 1970 he was awarded the M.B.E. in the New Years' Honours list for his contribution to Band work in South Australia.



GALVIN H. JOHN – Adjudicator

Present Conductor of the Tanunda Town Band, the leading South Australia A Grade Band which is over 100 years old.

Commenced banding at the age of 10 years on Euphonium and gained many successes in solo competitions. At the age of 16 years was playing solo Euphonium for the Tanunda Town Band.

Most of the early tuition was received from his Father, the late A. P. John, who was Conductor of the Tanunda Town Band for 22 years, and also from his brother the late Frank John, one of Australia's Champion Trombonists.

Has completed 15 most successful years as Conductor of the Tanunda Band, during which time they have won the Australian Championships and for 6 years were unbeaten in South Australia. During the past 15 years the Band has also won no fewer than 11 consecutive Test Pieces. They are the present South Australian Champions.

Was the planner and also the lecturer for the first Junior and Senior Band Seminars to be held in South Australia under the guidance of the South Australian Band Association. Is still actively engaged in Junior development.

As well as Conductor of the Tanunda Town Band has also trained a successful Junior Band at the Nuriootpa High School.

Was guest Conductor for massed Bands when Queen Mother visited South Australia in 1960, consisting of 600 Bandsmen. Was also adjudicator at Southport (Qld.) State Contest in 1970.





Band will fall in, in marching formation at AA and move off in Quick Time, playing Quickstep and march to point DD. On arriving at Point DD, Band will turn Left and march to point E, turn to the Right and Right Wheel, and march to point FF, and Halt with the front rank of the Band on the alignment FF and cease playing at the end of the strain. Drum-Major to be three paces in front of the centre of the Band.

Band will then move by the shortest way to point DD without playing, and Halt with the front rank on the alignment DD. Band will then move off from point DD on word of command, playing the Quickstep March, wheel to the Right and marching to point GG, wheeling to the Left between them and marching to point HH, wheeling to the Left between them and march to point BB, wheel to the Right and continue to point AA where the Band will Counter-march from front to rear and from flank to flank; on completing the Counter-march, the Band will move to point DD where it will again Counter-march from front to rear and from flank to flank as before. Halt with the Front Rank of Band on the alignment CC, Drum-Major to be three paces in front of the centre of the Band and cease playing at the end of the strain. After leaving Point AA the first time the Band will not again be dressed by word of Command. Band will be judged continuously from commencement to finish Diagram. All evolutions must be performed within the Diagram. Band means Front Rank.
