Foreword to . . . ROYAL SOUTH STREET SOCIETY'S

Australian Brass Band Championships

17TH TO 22ND OCTOBER, 1972

The South Street Society was formed on the 10th July, 1879 as a Literary and Debating Society having for its objects the encouragement of Debating and Literary activities amongst the youth of the City.

In 1891 the first Literary and Musical Competition was held for total cash prizes of £60 and attracting 250 Competitors.

As the years went by the scope of the Competition widened and the Society under wise guidance prospered.

In 1900 the first South Street Brass Band Contest was held and has continued for a period of 72 years (excepting various suspensions occasioned by two world wars and other causes).

Band music is the music of the people. Bands make a great impact on the lives of our young people and provides them with an amenity which educates them and teaches a knowledge and love of music — the finest of the arts.

With the provision of Contests everywhere, Bands are now able to bring their performances to near perfection and present to the public musical entertainment which is a delight to the ear and a credit to the amateur Band movement.

Brass Bands are world wide. In Australia alone the Australian Band Council has affiliated with its State Governing Bodies over 300 Bands.

Further on in this programme will be found the Winners of all "South Street" Band Contests since 1900.

In 1965 Royal South Street Society took an important step in its history, when the Society acquired Her Majesty's Theatre, Ballarat. The building has been renamed "Memorial Theatre".

The Annual Eisteddfod is now conducted in this Theatre with the exception of the Calisthenics Section and the Brass Band Contests which will continue to be staged at the Civic Hall so long as circumstances demand.
