MUSIC ADJUDICATORS

**PROFESSOR WALTER HARGREAVES FTCL (Cond) LTCL (Perf)
BBCM, MRST,gsm/**

Professor Walter Hargreaves from Deal, England, to some Queensland Bandsmen is no stranger as he was adjudicator for the Warana Band Contest some years ago. A visit he has never forgotten and which made him anxious to return.

He is a player, lecturer and teacher extraordinary; a human dynamo who answers to the nickname of "The Wee Professor."

With a name like Hargreaves naturally he's Scottish 'frae' Glasgow, where his father trained him in the NB Loco Works Band.

At 15 he was principal Cornet for the 7th Bat HLI.

He studied conducting, piano, cornet and french horn under Philip Halstead and graduated in 1928.

In the Theatres he played piano, trumpet and toured West Indies. In 1944 he was talked into conducting the Edinburgh Band, in 1946 the Cory Band and from then on he conducted Drybrook, Bristol, East Temperence, Bristol Aero Works. In 1952 he was appointed cornet Professor at the Royal Marines School of Music in Deal.

In 1963 he took over Brig House with whom he has been for many years.

Before returning to England, Walter will conduct seminars in Toowoomba, Maryborough, Rockhampton, Townsville and Cairns — Then on to New South Wales and Victoria.

GALVIN H. JOHN.

Present Conductor of the Tanunda Town Band, the leading S.A. A Grade Band which is over 100 years old.

Commenced banding at the age of 10 years on Euphonium and gained many successes in solo competitions. At the age of 16 years was playing solo Euphonium for the Tanunda Town Band.

Most of the early tuition was received from his father, the late A. P. John, who was conductor of the Tanunda Band for 22 years, and also from his brother, the late Frank John, one of Australia's Champion Trombonists.

Have completed 21 most successful years as Conductor of the Tanunda Band, during which time they have won the Australian Championships and for 6 years were unbeaten in SA. During the past 15 years the Band has also won no fewer than 11 consecutive Test Pieces. They are the present S.A. Champions.

DRILL ADJUDICATORS

JACK MARCHINGO

Jack Marchingo will be well known to most bands particularly in Queensland where he has adjudicated on three previous occasions while resident in Victoria. He commenced his band career with Marist Brothers College Band (Bendigo) at the age of 10 years. During the war he was bandmaster of the 2-38th Battalion Band. He was appointed to the Drill Adjudicators panel in Victoria in 1950 and has judged extensively in every state with the exception of Western Australia.

Previous to his taking up residence in Brisbane he had adjudicated at three Australian titles on this state, so he should be well known to most hands. Prior to his transferring to Queensland he had held the position of Secretary of the Victorian Bands League for thirteen years. His interest in the administration of banding included a term as secretary of the National Band Council where he represented Victoria for over 20 years and was recently honoured by the State Body with a life membership. He is also a life member of the Victorian Bands League and holds that organisation Badge of Merit. He takes an active interest in the Queensland Band Association and represents the Mt Isa Silver Band as delegate

Sgt KEVIN C. WENDT RAAF

A native of Bundaberg, he commenced his career as Drum Major of Bundaberg Municipal Band while still in his teens, at that time being the youngest Drum Major in Queensland, and was very successful in Diagram marching at Contests.

He joined the CMF in 1948 and was a member of the Wide Bay Regiment for seven years, attaining the rank of Lieutenant.

He was awarded numerous Champion Drum Major prizes at both State and National levels and toured NZ with Maryborough Federal Band (now Walkers Engineering) under the late J. J. Kelly. He also served with Mr Kelly and the Ipswich City Vice Regal Band. He has been Drum Major for various Queensland Bands from Mackay to Toowoomba.

In RAAF circles, he was Drum Major for Amberley and Richmond Bands, and whilst at the latter town, re-formed the Hawkesbury District Band, serving as president and DM.

Whilst serving in Singapore with the ANZUK Forces he was Drum Major of the Singapore Red Cross Military Band.

He has been a registered Drill Adjudicator for many years, and has officiated in this capacity on many occasions.

He was one of the founders of the Marching Girls' movement in Queensland, and was appointed the State's first Chief Marshal. He instructed the team "Legionnaires" which won the first Queensland Senior Teams Championship. He is a life member of the Bundaberg Girls Marching Association and the Hawkesbury District Band. He is presently serving at RAAF Base, Wagga Wagga, NSW.

BANDING IN QUEENSLAND

Let's take a journey back through the vintage years . . . although the existence of bands in Australia can be traced back to an early date, it is generally accepted that banding, really, got off the ground after the visit of the Besses-O-Th' Barn Band.

Spasmodic and isolated attempts to foster band contests were made, eventually an ambitious scheme was launched to promote inter-colonial contests. A national contest was held in Sydney on the 7th and 9th November, 1896. Bands from New South Wales, Queensland and Tasmania competed. The "A" grade section was won by "Newtown" playing "Lucia de Lammermor." Robert Garrison was second.

Victoria followed with a National Contest in 1897, in which bands from New South Wales, Tasmania and New Zealand competed.


The first band contest in Queensland was held in the Botanic Gardens, Brisbane. To compete in the contest the Gympie Oddfellows Band travelled to Brisbane to meet the Goliats of the Metropolis, that the other competitors withdrew was no fault of the Gympieites, and their effort was certainly meritorious, when it was taken into account that the band had to travel by any horse vehicle available to Tewantin and then proceed to Brisbane by water per the SS Noosa. Notables in the early days of banding in Queensland were enthusiasts Mr G. Bloomfield, Mr J. Henry Grice of Brisbane and Messrs Percival and Snell of Gympie, also Mr Alf Hall of Maryborough. To these gentlemen and others like them must go the credit of commencing the contesting idea which was to sweep the whole country and cause the general public to look forward to yearly competitions.

The first Australian championship held in Queensland was won by Ipswich City vice-Regal (A. Wade) by points in the tests.

According to official records book there were no "B" grades until 1914. "D" grade started in 1924, "C" grade started in 1914.

There have been 13 Australian championships held in Queensland. Some of the leading Queensland bands have been, Ipswich City Vice-Regal-Australian champions 1923, 1929, 1932. Maryborough Federal, 1947, 1952, 1960 and "B" Grade champions 1939. Townsville Railways "B" grade Australian champions, 1923, 1928, 1931 and "A" grade champions 1931. Cairns citizens "B" grade Australian champions 1935 NSW. "A" grade 1936 and New Zealand "A" grade championships 1936. Charters Towers citizens — Australian "B" and "C" grade 1929. Brisbane Excelsior — Australian champions — 1935 "B" grade 1929. Other top grade bands are south Brisbane Federal, Toowoomba Municipal and Nambour-Maroochy, and Rockhampton City.

50 YEARS AGO . . .



The Australian Commonwealth Band was formed in Sydney in late September, 1925, by Albert H. Baile and Vernon J. Beacroft to tour the World and compete in English contests. No-one realised at that time, that this band would be in existence for four years. The original members were:

Queensland: Bobby Gibson, Joe Hardy, Norman Forbes, Ossie Forbes, Albert Ovenden and Alex Francis-Smith who became Secretary and Advance Manager.

New South Wales: Archie Moore, Arthur Stender, Victor Baile, Fred Bartlett, Len Atkinson.

Victoria: Alfred Paxton, Harold Collins, Bill Murphy, Frank Alderman, Joe Clay, Jack Murphy, Alf Cornish, Clarrie (Larry) Collins, Fred Myers, Len Ryan.

South Australia: Harold Hewson, Geo Robertson, Jim Findlay.

West Australia: Harold Reid — Stan Brown joining in later.

The Band travelled to New Zealand playing at the Dunedin and South Seas Exhibition, all parts of Australia and Tasmania to South Africa, then to England, Scotland and Wales playing with success at the Bellevue, Halifax and Crystal Palace Contests.

Then to USA and Canada and while there, received a Contract to return in 1927 for the Western Fares Contract playing all Rodeos and beating the late John Philp Sousa for the job.

Returning to Australia playing New Zealand, Honolulu, Fiji and then a comprehensive tour of Australia until the end of 1929 when the Band disbanded due to the advent of 'talkies'.

Australia has a great deal to be proud of in these musicians who were acclaimed the world over as not only brilliant musicians, but wonderful Ambassadors for their States and Country.






NOTICES AND INSTRUCTIONS

This contest is held under the auspices of the Queensland Band Association and rules of the National Band Council and the QBA will apply throughout.

Bands must compete in all sections for which they have entered on the official programme.

All marching contests are compulsory.

Each Band Secretary shall collect the personal signature of each competitor on the form provided before each item at the Contest. These forms must be completed and returned to the Queensland Band Association officials before the Band may compete.

Secretaries and Conductors of Bands must observe perfect punctuality in assembling to draw for positions at times and places appointed and in placing their bands upon the contest stage.

Each Band in its numbered order must be ready to march on before the preceding one has left the stage. Each Band, after leaving the stage must play an item as next band gets ready, if required. The Band drawing last place will play the first band on to the stage, the first band will play on the second, and so on in their rotation.

The contest Delegates reserve the right to require the competing bands to take part in any street marching or playing they may deem desirable.

Any Band late at the drawing, or not ready to proceed with the Contest as directed by the QBA Officials, is liable to a fine or disqualification. The Delegates of the QBA have sole control of the music portion of the Contest, and all their directions must be carefully and promptly complied with.

The representatives of all of the Bands from whom places are to be drawn must present themselves at the time and place for such drawing. Any Band not present at the time appointed may not be eligible to compete. Defaulters may be fined.

Stage formation will be own choice.

All Competitors must be properly dressed.

No Band shall engage in any counter attraction at the Contest without the consent of the Committee.

Winners of any event must repeat their item if called upon to do so by the Delegates.

All items will be taken in order as arranged in this programme, unless otherwise notified, but the contest Delegates reserve the right to alter or amend the programme as required by circumstances.

Any courtesy items played during the Contest, whether at Street Marching, playing Bands on or off the platform, or at Inspection, shall not include any item that has been or will be played in a competitive number in such Contest.

All Bands must be in possession of the Palings Hymn Sheet and Massed Marches as selected.

Music in Diagram March and Street March will be "Own Choice," Bands must provide Music with Bars marked at the drawing for positions. Solo Cornet parts may be accepted for the Street March.

Competitors must conform to the commencing times as appearing in the programme.

The adjudicator's awards for solo and party competitions will be announced as decided by the Contest Delegates. Band awards will be announced at the end of each session.

No person (other than officials) will be allowed on or about the stage during the competition.

Bands must play a minimum of two (2) verses in each hymn tune.
Each band will be required to supply a copy of their OWN CHOICE
MUSIC.

SOLO AND PARTY COMPETITORS: Any competitor in solo and party competition arriving after drawing for positions has commenced will not be allowed to compete. Competitors must play in the position drawn.

No emergency players shall be allowed at any party item.

Soloists and parties playing own choice must provide a copy for the Judge otherwise they will not be allowed to compete. All music bars must be numbered.

In any event where age qualifications applies, birth certificates must be produced to Contest Delegates on demand.

When a solo item is in progress, only the competitor in that particular item will be allowed on the stage. Solo competitors will not be allowed on the stage while the preceding item is in progress or until they are called for the purpose of drawing for places in the item in which they will compete.

Competitors may tune their instruments with the piano prior to the commencement of each respective competition. Tuning will not be permitted during a competition.

After tuning, competitors must remain where directed until called to the stage to perform.

In Junior items, competitors must be under the stated age at the date of competition.

Competitors are reminded that in each competitive item they will be judged on Department. NOTE: Test Music cannot be played as own choice music.

CAPS shall not be worn when playing indoors.

DRUM Majors shall wear Caps at all times.






