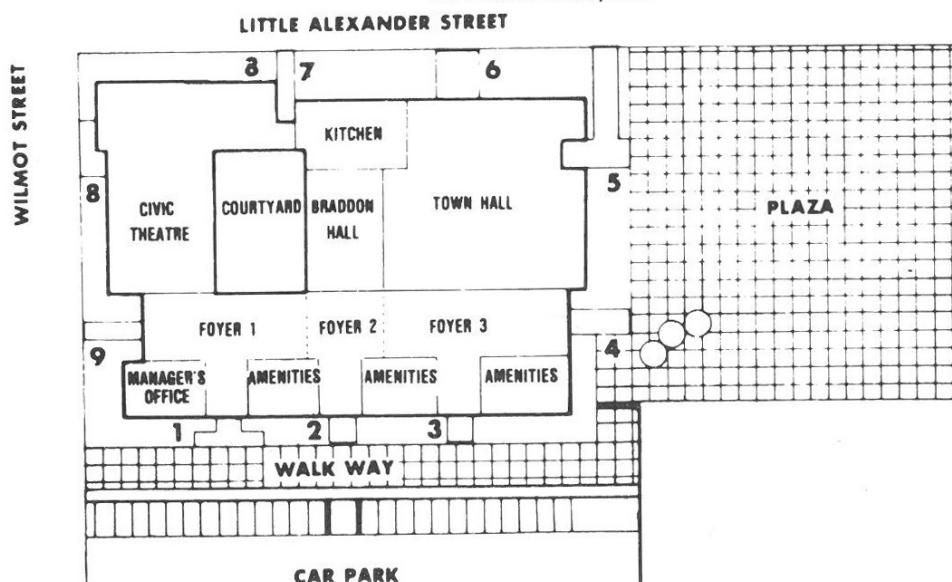

ADJUDICATORS

Roy Newsome (U.K.) B.Mus., F.R.C.O., A.R.C.M.



Roy Newsome, the Chief Adjudicator from the United Kingdom, was born in Yorkshire of a family whose forebears have been associated with brass banding for five (5) generations.

Roy started playing the cornet at the age of nine (9) years, and at the age of 36 years, he was invited to join the famous Black Dyke Mills Band. First as Bandmaster and later as Conductor, he helped in the making of thirty L.P. recordings, directed the Band in numerous broadcasts and T.V. programmes, led them in their Contest successes and conducted concerts in many parts of the U.K. and the Continent.

Roy is well known throughout the Brass Band movement as an Adjudicator, Teacher, Composer and Arranger. He has adjudicated the British Open Championships (1975); Granada Band of the Year (1977), and other National Contests in Norway, Switzerland and in Australia (1978).

In 1977, Roy relinquished his position with Black Dyke to take up positions of Musical Director of the Besses of the Barn Band and Professional Conductor of Sunlife Stanshawe Band. He has directed many courses for young bandsmen and his full time work is as Senior Lecturer at Salford College of Technology.

We look forward to having Roy adjudicate at the 1981 Australian National Titles here at Burnie.

Mr. John Allen (N.S.W.) B.A., B.Mus., M.Mus., Dip.Ed. A.L.C.M.



John is no stranger to Tasmania having been born and raised in Hobart. He was the Conductor of the Invermay Silver Band, Launceston City Band, and Latrobe Federal Band and Deputy Conductor of the Burnie Municipal Band. During this time he had success in Band Contesting and Solo and Party Eisteddfod competitions.

John studied overseas in Canada, U.S.A. and U.K. for a period of 11 years undertaking studies to further his music degree. He is presently a lecturer in Brass, Music Theory and Music Education at the Northern Rivers College of Advanced Education at Lismore N.S.W. and is the Conductor of the Senior and Junior Concert Bands at the College.

John has adjudicated at several State Band Contest and Solo and Party Competitions in Tasmania and we look forward to him adjudicating at these Championships.

Mr. Don Cushion (Vic.)



Don commenced his musical career with the Brunswick (Vic.) City Band at the age of 8 years. He was principal cornet at the age of 16 years of age and Deputy Conductor at 18 years of age.

He is the General Secretary of the Musicians Union of Australia and an Executive Member of the Federation of International Musicians in Zurich. He was for many years Principal Trumpet with the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra.

Don was adjudicated at many National and State Championships in Victoria and Tasmania as well as other states of Australia. His knowledge and experience over many years has assisted greatly the Brass Band movement of Australia.

We look forward to his visit to Tasmania for the 1981 National Championships and to renew acquaintances.

DRILL ADJUDICATORS

Mr. Doug Bradshaw (Tasmania)

Doug began his band music career with the R.A.N.R. Band and later with the R.A.A.F. Band to which he enlisted.

Some 30 years ago he became a Drum Major in Tasmania and won several Quickstep Diagram marches and on three occasions won the coveted "Bill Welling" Memorial Shield for the best drum major at the Tasmanian Bands League Contests.

Doug has been a member of the T.B.L. Drill Advisory Board as an adjudicator since 1964 and has judged many Tasmanian Contests including the 1969 and 1974 National Championships and at Tanunda South Australia in 1975. He is the holder of the T.B.L. Badge of Honour.



Mr. Neville Duniam (Q'land)

Neville began his band career with the R.S.L. Memorial Band (now Hobart Concert Brass) in Tasmania in 1937.

He enjoyed many successes as a Trombone player with several bands throughout Australia in particular the South Australian Police Band. In 1976 he qualified as a Drill Adjudicator and joined the Queensland Band Associations' Drill advisory Panel. In 1977 and 1979 he judged the Queensland Championships, in 1978 the National Titles in Melbourne and 1980 at Mount Gambier in South Australia.

Neville is a Delegate on the Queensland Band Association and a member of the Drill Advisory Panel.

MARCHING:

1. All rules of the National Band Council shall apply throughout the contest, together with any other rules as submitted herewith.
2. Bands and Soloists must play in the order in which they appear in the programme.
3. All or any competitors in Junior Sections may be required to produce evidence of their age prior to commencement of the contest.
4. Age as referred to for Juniors shall mean the age of the contestant as at the date of the Contest.
5. Bandsmen and bandswomen must wear a uniform and each Quartet must consist of members of the same Band (including the conductor).
6. Competitors in the Quartet Sections shall be allowed the services of their Bandmaster/Conductor or a member of their Band as conductor.
7. Trumpets and French Horns may only be used in accordance with National Band Council Rule 15A.
8. Competing Bands, Quartets and Soloists must be ready to play immediately the previous competitor is finished.
9. Bands will not be permitted to tune up on stage.
10. The Committee reserves the right to withhold prize money from any Band which does not participate in all events listed on the schedule excluding those specifically stated as Optional.
