




I am confident that Competitors, supporters and all those attending these Championships will be assured a most enjoyable and rewarding weekend of music and marching.

CHIEF ADJUDICATOR GOFF RICHARDS

Goff Richards was born in Cornwall. He studied at the Royal College of Music, London, and Reading University, and is now well established as a Composer, Arranger and Musical Director. His works have been performed by The King's Singers, The Swingle Singers, London Brass, Evelyn Glennie, Benjamin Luxon, Huddersfield Choral Society, various BBC Ensembles and leading Brass and Military Bands. He writes extensively for TV and Radio, in such diverse fields as 'Songs of Praise' 'Listen to the Band' - where he was recently commissioned to produce a work for the largest gathering of Brass musicians ever to be recorded - and for his many ensembles - Burnished Brass, The Arcadians, Fifty/Fifty, Percussion Plus and The Goff Richards Orchestra. Three famous bands - BNFL, Brighouse and Rastrick and Britannia Building Society have produced recordings entirely of his work, and a new CD featuring his Arcadians will be released soon. As an adjudicator, Goff Richards is widely travelled, having judged at the European Brass Band Championships, the British Brass, Wind and Big Band Championships, the New Zealand National Brass Band Championships, 'Brass in Concert,' Spennymoor, 'Siddis Brass,' Norway, the Swiss Entertainment Contest, the National Male Voice Choir Championships of Britain, and various Band contests for BBC TV and Radio. For many years he Lectured in Arranging and directed the Jazz Orchestra at Salford College of Technology where he was awarded an Honorary GDBM and the title Director Big Band Laureate. He is a Bard of the Cornish Gorsedd, a member of the British Music Writers Council Committee and a former member of the BBC's Central Music Advisory Committee. He is currently an External Examiner for the University of Salford.

Mervyn Simpson

Mervyn George Dantry Simpson was born in 1915 in Oakleigh, Victoria and was only eight years old when he first showed his natural talent by picking up and playing a bugle with the Salvation Army. And that was the start of a brilliant musical career which was to span more than 60 years of outstanding achievements in many spheres of music.

This outstanding Melbourne trumpeter, bandmaster and teacher was self-taught; he began brass band playing while still a teenager and graduated to professional dance bands, grand opera, ballet, and theatre and symphony orchestras. Australasian Band & Orchestra News in 1934 reported the award of a Liberati scholarship to Mervyn Simpson (soprano,) by H. Archie Richardson, a widely-known cornet and trumpet player just returned from a successful career in band work in the United States; Merv was highly recommended by Percy Code. (Liberati was one of the great American concert bands.) At Malvern Municipal and Tramways Band Merv was solo cornet and deputy conductor for seven years, as well as teacher and conductor of the Junior Band. Captain Harry Shugg was the Malvern Bandmaster and he was a great influence and inspiration to Merv whom he believed had the makings of a very fine instrumentalist and how right he was!

From the very beginning Merv was dedicated to following Harry Shugg's method of paying attention to the minute details so often neglected by others. As Bandmaster of Stawell Brass Band he is quoted as saying: "A band should be one hundred per cent in such details as attack, release, precision and note valuation etc. No matter what the members' technical ability, these details should be strictly observed." Stawell Band had a very successful time under Merv's leadership, and it was with much regret that he was farewelled on his return to Melbourne in the early 1940s.

It was while at Stawell that Mervyn married his long-time girlfriend, Miss Mavis Darby of Caulfield; they met through music - her father, William Darby, played with Prahran City band. They had three sons - Graeme (who played under Merv in Melbourne Fire Brigade Band,) Bruse and Ian. Merv was a keen sportsman, representing Victoria as an "A" grade baseballer; he also played tennis and golf, as well as district cricket with Prahran. Today Mavis is still Merv's No. 1 fan, and it was with great pride that she displayed the British Empire Medal awarded to Mervyn George Dantry Simpson in 1977 "For services to music."

Merv was invited to join the Melbourne symphony Orchestra in 1945, and within a week was in the principal trumpet seat, a position he was to occupy until his retirement 31 years later; he is one of a small handful of musicians in the world to hold down this key and demanding position in a major orchestra for such a long period. Many visiting conductors praised his concerto performances; "Concertino for Trumpet and Orchestra" was dedicated to Mervyn Simpson by its French composer, Raymond Loucheur, when "Melbourne's No. 1 trumpeter" played it, as it was considered too difficult for most European trumpeters. The Victorian Trumpet Trio - Merv Simpson, Stan Roberts and George Dobson - was highly regarded and their history includes winning the "Swallow's Parade" in 1956.

His inspiring conducting of bands brought forth success after success, and when Merv took up the baton with the re-formed Melbourne Fire Brigade Band his enthusiasm and expertise led them to Australian Championships. When the Band was disbanded, Merv moved to Footscray-Yarraville Band and a period of great achievement followed his appointment, including being the Australian Open Champion Band on three occasions. Footscray-Yarraville Band was invited to compete in the International Band Contest held in Toronto, Canada in 1975 - and under Merv's detailed positive flawless direction they won and established themselves as one of the world's greatest brass bands.

The Victorian bands' League has shown their admiration and respect for Merv by instituting the annual MERVYN SIMPSON TROPHY in his honour; this is presented to the outstanding Victorian Band of the year based on band competition results - 1997's award was won by Kew Brass.

Mervyn G.D. Simpson was a legend in his own time, a perfectionist with a meticulous technique, perfect sense of musical interpretation and overwhelming dedication and enthusiasm. Merv was a conductor, but basically he was a teacher because of his ability to analyse every detail of the music to discover the meaning of every note in the music; many of his students became notable players, such as Robert Simms, Wayne Bowden, Merv Cavell and Barry McKimm.

A tribute to this brilliant and talented Australian musician on his death in 1986 says it all:

MERVYN SIMPSON -

**Man of Brass, Stupendous Band Trainer,
Magnificent Player and Leader. Never forgotten.**





The "AUSTRALIAN BAND OF THE SOMME" is being formed with musicians drawn from every state and territory in order to take part in events marking the 80th Anniversary of the end of World War 1 in Europe.

The Title "AUSTRALIAN BAND OF THE SOMME" was conferred recently by the French Consul General "...With the right to carry the Flag, use the colours and insignia..."

Although much of the three week tour has a "Military" flavour, there is more than enough time for sight seeing etc. (Depart Sydney 2nd July)



In **France**, the Band will perform in **Paris**, the National War Memorial in Villers Bretonneux, Bullecourt, Arras, Poziers (Hamel and Fromelles, where the Prime Minister will unveil "Digger" memorial statues). We will also visit Verdun, Reims, Compiegne, Rouen, Caen and Bayeux.

In **Belgium**, the Band will perform in **Brussels**, and the Menin Gate at Ypres, visiting Waterloo and Mons.

Crossing the Channel to the **U.K.** (Calais to Dover) with sight seeing on route to **London** with several performances in this great city. We are also negotiating for an appearance at the World's Biggest Tattoo, the Royal Tournament, and if we can fit it in, a guest appearance at the World Band Championships, also in London (Don't worry, still time for shopping at the summer sales in Oxford Street)
