





James Curnow

James Curnow, born in Port Huron, Michigan, received his initial musical training in the public schools and The Salvation Army Instrumental programs. He is president, composer and educational consultant for Curnow Music Press, Inc. of Nicholasville, Kentucky, publishers of significant music for concert band and brass band. He also serves as Composer-in-residence (Emeritus) on the faculty of Asbury College in Wilmore, Kentucky, and is editor of all music publications for The Salvation Army in Atlanta, Georgia.



James Curnow has taught in all areas of instrumental music, both in public schools and at the college and university level for 30 years. He is a member of several professional organizations, including the American Bandmasters Association, College Band Directors National Association, National Band Association and the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP). In 1980 he received the National Band Association's Citation of Excellence. In 1985, while a tenured Associate Professor at the University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana, he was honored as an outstanding faculty member. Among his most recent honors are inclusion in *Who's Who in America*, *Who's Who in the South and Southwest*, and *Composer of the Year* (1997) by the Kentucky Music Teachers Association and the National Music Teachers Association. He has received annual ASCAP standard awards since 1979.

He has been commissioned to write over two hundred works for concert band, brass band, orchestra, choir and various vocal and instrumental ensembles. His published works now number well over four hundred. His most recent commissions include the Tokyo Symphony Orchestra, the United States Army Band, Roger Behrend and the DEG Music Products, Inc. and Willson Band Instrument Companies, *the Olympic Fanfare and Theme for the Olympic Flag* for the Atlanta Olympic Games, the Kentucky Music Teachers Association/National Music Teachers Association in 1997 *On Poems of John Keats for String Quartet*, as well as works for the University of North Carolina at Greensboro, Michigan State University Bands, Capital Quartet of Washington, DC, the 2005 Falcone Euphonium and Tuba Festival Twentieth Anniversary and 2007 Phi Beta Mu (Ohio) commission to honor Dr. Timothy Swinehart of Capital University).



Professor David King

David King has an enviable record of musical accomplishments and successes both as an instrumentalist and conductor. He studied trumpet and cornet at the Sydney Conservatorium and music education with Alan Thrift at Avondale College, NSW, graduating in 1978. In 1982, as Australian Cornet Champion he was awarded a scholarship to study music at Salford University College, Manchester, where he graduated with distinction in Performance in 1985. Today he is Chair of Music (Performance) at that University. In Britain, David King pursued a distinguished career as a cornet soloist, winning the title 'North of England Solo Champion' on three occasions and was unbeaten on Bb Cornet at the British Open Solo Championships for five consecutive years. He represented the United

Kingdom in 1992 as 'British Open Solo Champion' and won the prestigious 'International Brass Musician of the Year' title in Auckland.

A member of the Adelphi Research Institute for Creative Arts and Social Sciences, University of Salford, King completed his Doctor of Musical Arts degree in 2000.

As a conductor, Professor King holds a prominent position in Europe and has represented England in the European Brass Band Championships on eleven occasions as a conductor and has won the title ten times, twice with Black Dyke Mills Band and eight times with the Yorkshire Building Society Band.

In 2002 David King was appointed Musical Director of the 'Massed Bands of the North West of England' to perform in the closing ceremony of the Manchester Commonwealth Games and has been awarded the Iles Medal by 'The Worshipful Company of Musicians' London in recognition of his services to British music.

Professor King is founder and director of 'National Australia Brass'.



Squadron Leader John Buckley

John Buckley's musical career began at age 12 as a brass and woodwind instrumentalist. At 16, he enlisted as a musician in the Australian Defence Force. As a performer he was awarded Associate in Music (A.Mus.A.), Licentiate Trinity College of Music, London (LTCL) and admitted as a Fellow of Trinity College of Music, London (FTCL).

In 1993, the RAAF selected him to attend a two-year Band Officer Course at the Defence Force School of Music with a view to appointment as an Air Force Officer and Music Director. He studied conducting with Professor Robert Rosen and Aural/Pedagogy with Ms Ingrid Liebbrandt. On graduation, he won the Officer Commanding / Chief Instructor's prize for the top student in conducting. He also won the Percy Grainger Prize for the top student for leadership, management skills and personal qualities. He was the first RAAF student to achieve this, graduating as Dux in 1995 with a Graduate Diploma in Applied Music.

John was posted to the Royal Australian Air Force Air Command Band, Sydney in November 1995 and appointed its Commanding Officer / Music Director in July 2000 prior to its disbandment in 2008. Under his direction, the Air Command Band gained a worldwide reputation for outstanding performance and musical excellence. He led the band in performances at the 2000 Sydney Olympic and Paralympic games, 2001 Federation celebrations, concert tours of East Timor, Anzac Day commemorations at Gallipoli and a deployment to Iraq and Afghanistan. He is also very active locally and nationally, as a conductor, clinician, adjudicator, and teacher working in many public and private schools throughout Sydney.

He continues to encourage emerging composers to write exciting new repertoire for the Wind Symphony particularly students at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music and the Australian Institute of Music. He is currently the Officer-In-Charge of the Sydney Detachment of the Air Force Band, Music Director of the Wind Symphony at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music, the Sydney Wind Symphony, SHORE School Senior Orchestra and a regular adjudicator for the Yamaha Band Festival, Sydney Performing Arts Challenge and the Band Association of NSW.

Brian Nixon

After studying classical guitar for six years, **Brian Nixon** became more interested in hitting things than plucking them. In 1977, while studying under Richard Miller and playing with the award winning Willoughby Brass Band (where he has now been made a life member) and the Sydney Youth Orchestra, Brian was chosen to represent Australia as a percussionist in the first Asian Regional Youth Music Camp held in Manila, the Philippines. Since then, as a freelance drummer, timpanist and percussionist, Brian has worked through a very wide spectrum of the music industry. As a drummer, he has backed many local and international rock and club acts. He performs regularly with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra having been a guest principal percussionist on many occasions and is currently on contract as Assistant Principal timpanist. He is also the Australian Brandenburg Orchestra and the Australian Chamber Orchestra's principal timpanist. He has toured the United States of America, Europe, Japan, Thailand and Italy with the SSO; Japan and Europe with the ACO and Europe with the ABO.

As well as the major orchestras, Brian has performed with and/or recorded for such diverse groups as the Australia Ensemble, Sydney Dance Company, The Midday Show Band, The Seymour Group, Synergy Percussion, INXS, Rolf Harris, Neil Finn, John Williams, John Farnham, Harry Connick Jr. and Silverchair – just to name a few. As a session musician, he has performed on over one hundred albums and has worked on countless radio/TV and cinema jingles, documentaries and film scores, from Hanna-Barbera cartoons to feature films the likes of Happy Feet and Australia. Brian Nixon has also composed percussion solos and adjudicated for many NSW and national competitions. He has examined for the AMEB, NSW Brass Band Association, NSW Conservatorium and Canberra School of Music and is involved in the Australian Youth Orchestra's program of workshops and national auditioning. Brian still directs percussion studies at Barker College, Hornsby where he started the program in 1978.




Andrew Snell

Andrew Snell began playing trombone at the age of 11. After playing with the local town bands and county youth bands and orchestras he moved to Manchester to study at University College, Salford. After gaining a B.A. (Hons) in Band Musicianship Andrew took up the position of Bass Trombone with the Grimethorpe Colliery Band.

With Grimethorpe, he toured extensively, including Australia, Japan, Germany, Switzerland, France, New Zealand and Hong Kong. He also won the National Brass Band Championships and the British Open Championships, the two premier band competitions in the UK. Mr. Snell has also been involved in the recording of many CDs, radio and television programs, including the Eurovision Song Contest, the making of the hit film *Brassed Off!*

His conducting experience began at college where he studied under Dave King and Roy Newsome. He returned to Salford in 1997 where he was a finalist in the Young Conductor of the Year competition and has conducted bands including Grimethorpe, Yorkshire Imps, British Steel Teeside and E.Y.M.S. Whilst conducting E.Y.M.S. the band won the North of England Championship and gained a place in the prizes at the prestigious Grand Shield Contest. He has also conducted at contests as varied as The All-England Masters Championship and the National Mineworkers Brass Band Championship.

Andrew Snell has performed with musicians as diverse as Vanessa Mae, Lesley Garrett, James Morrison and Nigel Kennedy. He left Grimethorpe in 2002 after 11 years as a member and emigrated to New Zealand where he was engaged as Musical Director with Waitakere City 'Trusts' Brass; one of New Zealand's premiere brass bands, which he directed to become the Champion Band of Australia at Easter 2003 in Newcastle. Since leaving NZ for Australia in 2004 he has worked as Lecturer in Brass and Musicianship at Charles Darwin University, Orchestra Manager for the Australian Opera and Ballet Orchestra in Sydney and has recently taken up the role of Executive Director of the Wollongong Conservatorium of Music. He is also Musical Director of the Willoughby Band, one of Australia's top A-grade bands.



Paul Terracini

Paul Terracini, an Australian musician, conductor, composer and arranger, has previously held permanent positions as Principal Trumpet in the Australian Opera and Ballet Orchestra; Lecturer in Trumpet, Concert Band, Brass Ensemble and Big Band at the QLD Conservatorium of Music and Solo Trumpet in the Danish Chamber Players, Denmark.

Terracini has performed as soloist in Europe, USA, England and Asia. In Australia, he has appeared as trumpet soloist with the Melbourne Symphony Orchestra, QLD Symphony Orchestra, Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra and the West Australian Symphony Orchestra. Whilst working at the QLD Conservatorium from 1982-1988, he conducted the

Conservatorium's Concert Band, Brass Ensemble and Big Band.

As a member of the Danish Chamber Players, he performed all over eastern and western Europe, South America, Asia and Australia. He has also been guest professor at several conservatoriums in Europe and China. Terracini has conducted ten CDs with the Prague Symphony Orchestra as well as working as an opera conductor in Germany, Denmark and Italy. For the last 10 years he has written and conducted a great deal of music for film and television.

His music for the two-part television series, "Hymns of the Forefathers I&II" for ABC-TV, received international acclaim and was released on CD and DVD by ABC Classics. His title music for the international television series, "Classical Destinations," was featured on the "Number 1 Classical Album of 2007", released by Decca, the prestigious classical music label. In 2008, he composed the title music for second series of "Classical Destinations", featuring Richard Tognietti with the Australian Chamber Orchestra. Other recent commissions have included orchestrating music for a new CD of french horn music conducted by Barry Tuckwell, and appearing as guest conductor in orchestral concerts at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music. He has been Musical Director of St Marys Band Club Brass since 2008.



Warwick Tyrrell

One of Australia's most accomplished musicians, **Warwick Tyrrell** was Principal Trombonist of the London Philharmonic Orchestra for three years and the Adelaide Symphony for nine. Outright Winner of The International Trombone Competition 1998. He has appeared as a Concerto Soloist with the Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide,

Queensland and Tasmanian Symphony Orchestras as well as The London Philharmonic.

The ABC offered Warwick a contract to record trombone concertos for sale internationally. It was described in one recording guide as "the most exciting offering to come from the ABC Classics label to date". He also was awarded first prize in the 1984 ABC Instrumental and Vocal Competition.

Warwick now runs a highly successful business which puts on shows in Primary and Pre-Schools all over Australia. It promotes good safety and communication values through school concerts that he writes and performs - compering concerts to over 50,000 Aussie kids.

Four years ago Warwick began conducting Sutherland Shire Brass, building them into one of the most successful concert-giving bands.

Warwick is also Artistic Director to The Bankstown Carols - a large outdoor Christmas event which attracts up to 10,000 at the evening concert.


He holds a paid position with the Queensland Youth Orchestra - a Fellowship supported by the Australia Council. He regularly travels to Brisbane and works with The QYO under the mentorship of one of Australia's leading Youth Educators - Mr John Curro. Warwick enjoys adjudicating - most recently at the 2008 Tasmanian State Band Championships and also this year at the Engadine Music Festival where he listened to 100 bands in just five days.

Peter Walmsley OAM

Peter Walmsley O.A.M., A.MUS.A., L.T.C.L., F.T.C.L. began his musical career in 1955 under his father's tuition of his father, Harold Walmsley, in Broken Hill. As a soloist he has won over 40 first prizes in State and National competitions including NSW Champion of Champions and the Australian Champion of Champions - the first occasion at the age of 15, the youngest to date.

Playing trumpet he won the instrumental section of the ABC's Concerto Competition in Adelaide in 1964 and was a Commonwealth finalist in Melbourne. In 1965 he studied with the late Mervyn Simpson, conducted the Footscray-Yarraville Band and did casual orchestral, theatre and dance band playing. In 1967 Peter was appointed to the trumpet section of the Sydney Symphony Orchestra but retired in 2001. He has performed as a soloist, directed and played with many brass ensembles, orchestras and choirs and worked in all types of professional orchestras - chamber, opera, recording for films and commercials. Teaching brass has occupied much of the past forty years and a number of his former students hold professional positions in the major Australian orchestras. He has been a member of the staff at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music, Sydney University, the Nepean Advanced College of Education and University of NSW. He has adjudicated in every State of Australia and New Zealand at all the major contests and eisteddfods and has conducted workshops at most metropolitan and country centres and is instrumental advisor to Boosey & Hawkes (Australia). Peter is a senior examiner for the Australian Music Examinations Board and brass adviser to the AMEB in New South Wales.

Peter was appointed Musical Director of the NSW State Youth Band and in 1992 conducted the Willoughby Band on a highly successful tour to Tokyo, Japan, performing varied styles of concerts and playing to capacity audiences. In 1998 the Australian Music Examinations Board commissioned him to write a syllabus for wind and brass ensemble examinations, Grades 2 to 8. He was awarded an Order of Australia medal (OAM) in 2003 for his services to community music and brass bands.






The Fireman's Helmet

The first Melbourne Fire Brigade (MFB) Band existed from 1900 to 1950, and won the Australian National Championship four times. It was never defeated in a marching competition. It was disbanded (no pun intended!) in 1950 whilst it was still the Australian Champion band.

In its second existence from 1965 to 1970 the Band under Mervyn Simpson won six contests including two Australian Championships (1968 and 1970). History repeated itself, when in November 1970, the Melbourne Fire Brigades' Board decided not to continue its support for the Band, which consequently disbanded again. The Band therefore has the dubious honour of being the only band disbanded twice whilst holding the Australian 'A' Grade Championship! Alan Ball was a BBb bass player with the Band. With some eleven other members he followed Bandmaster Mervyn Simpson to Footscray City Band in 1971.

In 1972 Alan donated his brass fireman's helmet, and MFB Superintendent Jack McKimm, who was also Manager and Deputy Conductor of the band, organized its being mounted as a trophy. While it was not openly stated, the connotation was that the trophy was a memorial to the Melbourne Fire Brigade Band.

It was therefore fitting that Footscray City Band, under the baton of Mervyn Simpson, former Bandmaster of the Melbourne Fire Brigades Band, won the trophy in the three following consecutive years of 1972, 1973 and 1974.

Names of players from the MFB Band who went to, or played with, Footscray-Yarraville include: Jack McKimm (cornet), Merv Cavell (cornet), Arthur Withers (cornet), Henry Bowyer (cornet), Alan McKimm (cornet and flugel horn), Doug Trotman (tenor horn), Ian Fowler (tenor horn), Claude Scanlon (baritone), Bill Wheatley (euphonium), Charlie Ring (trombone), Laurie Lavelle (Eb bass), Albert Hathaway (Eb bass), Alan Ball (BBb bass), Arthur Fenton (percussion).







Adjudicator Inspection. **Sergeant Peter Ryan** is the Drum Major of the Band of the University of New South Wales Regiment (UNSWR). Sergeant Ryan has been in the Army Reserve for 37 years, 22 years as Drum Major of UNSWR. UNSWR is the last band in the Australian Defence Force (ADF) to still parade as a brass band. Peter is also the Drum Major of the NSW Fire Brigades Band.

Adjudicator Inspection. A member of Army Reserve bands for 10 years, **Kathryn Murray** has experienced band life as instrumentalist, drum major and conductor. She received her Bachelor of Music (Performance) majoring in trombone in 1999 and was Drum Major of the 23 Field Regiment Royal Australian Artillery Band from 2001 – 2006. She has experience bringing musicians with minimal marching band experience to performance standard within very short periods of time and believes that high standards in both the musical and visual aspects of a marching band's performance are important. Kathryn received instruction from Drum Majors of the UK Army, Airforce and Royal Marines as well as completing the Australian Regular Army's Drum Major course.

Adjudicator Files, timing after change of direction B & C Grades. **David Peters** commenced his banding involvement in 1965 with Launceston RSL Brass - then called the Invermay Silver Band - and was actively involved as player and drum major, until moving to Hobart in 2003, and holds Life Membership. In addition to a successes at Tasmanian State Championships, David led the band to win the National Marching Championship in Launceston in 1993 and Newcastle in 1997. On both occasions, and again in 2000, he won the prestigious Jim Brill Memorial trophy for the Champion Drum Major.

Adjudicator Files, timing after change of direction A & D Grades. **Rex Hoare** joined Tuggerah Lakes District Band on the NSW central coast in 1969 with many marching trophies taking pride of place in the band's hall. Rex played with the NSW Fire Brigades band for several years in the 1980s on bass trombone. After playing on permit with the Sutherland Shire Silver Band (now Sutherland Shire Brass) in the early 90s, he joined as a registered member. He took over as Drum Major "on a temporary basis" and 15 years later still holds the position. The band enjoys "raising an eyebrow or two" at competitions by playing "less-than-orthodox" street march music, and doing something that is "definitely different" for the change of direction.

Adjudicator Step off, dressing, before change of direction B & C Grades. **David Kurthi** commenced playing percussion with Waratah-Mayfield Brass in Newcastle at the age of thirteen. David won the U18 Australian National Drum Championship in 1975 and was regularly place in NSW and Regional Championships. David's interest was in marching, and when given the opportunity to lead the NPCBCBB, he was found to be a natural. Training and leading the Band, David won eight Youth Club Championships, five Australian Championships and in 1989, was invited to train and lead the St Mary's Band Club Brass Band at the B Grade New Zealand National Championships. David has had a continuing association with the St Mary's Band Club Brass Band winning four Australian National Drum Major Awards.

Adjudicator Step off, dressing, before change of direction A & D Grades. **Kevin Skues** is a trombone player who currently plays with Parramatta City Band, the N.S.W. Ambulance Band, Balmain Sinfonia and conducts Yagoona District Band. He has his own business as a multi-instrumental music teacher and currently runs the band programs in two high schools and three primary schools in Southern Sydney. Kevin has served as an Army Reserve musician for 31 years and was Bandmaster of the 23 Field Regiment, Royal Australian Artillery Band from 1989 – 2006. During this time he became the first Army Reserve musician to become fully qualified as an Australian Army Band Corps Warrant Officer. He also started and developed a drum corps from the local Army Cadet Corps.

Music Adjudicator: Squadron Leader John Buckley. John's musical career began at age 12 as a brass and woodwind instrumentalist. At 16, he enlisted as a musician in the Australian Defence Force. As a performer he was awarded Associate in Music (A.Mus.A.), Licentiate Trinity College of Music, London (LTCL) and admitted as a Fellow of Trinity College of Music, London (FTCL). He is currently the Officer-In-Charge of the Sydney Detachment of the Air Force Band, Music Director of the Wind Symphony at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music, the Sydney Wind Symphony, SHORE School Senior Orchestra and a regular adjudicator for the Yamaha Band Festival, Sydney Performing Arts Challenge and the Band Association of NSW





