



# Adjudicators

## Chief Adjudicator, Brass Bands - Peter Walmsley OAM



Peter Walmsley commenced his musical career in Broken Hill in the 1950's. He played tenor horn, cornet and trumpet; winning over 40 first prizes in State and National competitions. He also studied piano to Diploma level at the Elder Conservatorium in Adelaide.

Playing trumpet, Peter won the South Australian instrumental section of the ABC Concerto Competition in 1964. In 1967, he was appointed to the trumpet section of the Sydney Symphony Orchestra. As well as orchestral work, he has performed with many brass ensembles, and has worked as a soloist in a wide variety of contexts.

Teaching brass has occupied much of the last forty years, and he has been a member of the staff at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music, Sydney University, the Nepean Advanced College of Education and the University of NSW. Peter has also adjudicated at major competitions and eisteddfods throughout Australia and New Zealand.

## Chief Adjudicator, Concert Bands - Graham Lloyd



Graham Lloyd's early music interests saw him learning violin and cello at Secondary School after which he enlisted into the Australian Regular Army in 1972 as an Apprentice Musician studying the clarinet. Upon graduation from the Army Apprentices School in 1973, he received the Boosey and Hawkes prize for instrumental proficiency.

In February 2004, Graham accepted the position of Officer Commanding/Chief Instructor at the Defence Force School of Music at the Simpson Barracks.

Graham's main music interests are composing, arranging, teaching and conducting. His Concert Band work, *Prelude for a Festival*, won the 1988 Yamaha Composer of the Year award. Additionally, he has arranged and composed over 500 works for Concert Bands, Brass Bands and orchestras for every possible occasion from major concerts in the Opera House to the Edinburgh Military Tattoo in Sydney in 2005. He completed his Masters in music composition at Melbourne University in 1999 studying with his friend and mentor, Professor Brenton Broadstock. Graham has been published by Barnhouse Publications in the US, De Haske in Europe and Muso's Media in Australia.

Graham is regularly called upon to adjudicate state and National community band festivals, eisteddfods, solo and small group contests and to lecture on various music subjects including arranging, composition and conducting. He lectures at various music institutions including Melbourne University's Music Faculty.



## Adjudicator Bill Broughton



Bill Broughton began his career as a studio musician in 1968 and soon was playing trombone for most of the television and motion picture studios in Hollywood. Some of the television shows are “Bonanza,” “Gunsmoke,” “Little House On The Prairie,” “Kojak,” “Police Woman,” “Hawaii 5-0,” “The Incredible Hulk,” “Scoobie-Doo”. Some of the motion pictures that Bill has played on are “Jaws 2,” “The Godfather II”, “Honey I Blew Up The Kid,” “Homeward Bound,” “For Love Or Money,” (featured soloist), “Baby’s Day Out,” and “Miracle On 34th Street”, “Homeward Bound II” (Lost In San Francisco), to name a few.

In 1991 Bill was composer/music director of the international Miss World competition in Atlanta, Georgia. and in 1994, Intersound International produced eight albums entitled The Magic of The Movies with Bill as artist and conductor and they were released nationally in the USA. The titles of the albums are: The Great Epics, Final Frontier, Music For Murder, War Is Hell, Wild Wild Westerns, Sex and Seduction, Heartstrings and Fine Romance. 1994 also marked the release of two Jazz albums featuring Ten Trombones and Rhythm with Bill as performer and arranger. Billboard magazine gave Spiritual To The Bone 1 & 2 a great review and it they acclaimed internationally.

In 1996, Bill was the Music Director for the opening and closing ceremonies for the 1996 Atlanta Paralympics Games. His responsibilities included writing original music as well as conduct and oversee any and all music production for the event.

Bill’s brass band compositions and arrangements have been played and/or recorded internationally for many years. His Flugel Horn Concerto “Trilogy” was the open contest piece for Flugel Horn at National Comps in Brisbane, a few years ago In June 2011 at the International Staff Band of the Salvation Army 120 anniversary Bill had two of his arrangements performed at the Royal Albert Hall Concert, one by the Melbourne Staff band and one as a massed band performance with New York, Chicago, Canadian, Japanese, German, Amsterdam, Melbourne and International Staff Bands.

Moving to Australia in 2003, Bill gained permanent residency and then became an Australian citizen in 2006 Bill (composer/artist/ conductor/producer/author/motivator) spends his time composing and arranging commissions for various genres in Orchestra, Concert Band, Brass Band, Big Band and other musical groups. He was, from 2003-07, part-time lecturer at Adelaide University Elder School of Music with large and small ensembles, composition/arranging, film scoring, one to one tutoring and brass masters classes. He still produces his own solo and other CD’s, also travels interstate lecturing at other schools, performing as conductor and soloist, adjudicating, as well as giving motivational presentations. He has written and published two books, both being inspirational in content.

## Adjudicator - Bruce Armstrong



The key person in any brass band is the Musical Director or Bandmaster. The success or otherwise of a band is directly attributed to the musical skill, organisational abilities and dedication of its musical director. The Warragul Band are fortunate to have the services of one of the best in the land. Bruce Armstrong, commonly known amongst banding circles as ‘Mr A’.

Born in Hay NSW, Bruce spent his childhood at Bendigo in central Victoria. The Armstrong family were generally musical with the previous three generations producing singers of some renown. Mr “A” commenced his musical career as a choir boy but was given the ‘boot’ at a tender age after being caught fighting in the choir stalls. He began learning cornet with the Bendigo Citizens & Boys Band (now Strathfieldsaye) at age nine. He is now a life member of that band as well as Warragul Municipal. Whilst at Bendigo he became principal trumpet player with the Bendigo Concert Orchestra and at the same time had his own 8+ piece dance band.

In 1963 he left Bendigo for Melbourne and two years of teacher training. Whilst there he played solo cornet with the Kew Citizens Band, an association which continued until 1968. He competed as a soloist, in small ensembles and in band contests for many years, with the view that competing provides feedback on performance, and is directed at improving rather than winning.

He has provided many hundreds of people with a love of music, a sound basic education in its production and a lifetime of interest.



# Drill Adjudicators

## Chief Drill Adjudicator - Ben Fixter



After completing a Bachelor of Arts (Music) in 1995 at the University of Southern Queensland, Ben was employed as an Instrumental Music Instructor at several schools in Central Queensland for 4 years. He attained his Trinity College Licentiate Diploma (performer) on trumpet in 1996.

In 1999 he returned to university to complete a post-graduate Bachelor of Education (Primary), after which he chose to pursue a career in the Australian Defence Force (ADF). After serving in Army bands in Sydney, Canberra and Townsville, Ben is now an instructor at the Defence Force School of Music in Melbourne.

Ben has been an active member of brass bands since 1985, and during this time has performed duties as both a music and drill adjudicator at local, state and national competitions. He also boasts successes as a performer, Music Director and Drum Major.

The 2012 Nationals in Melbourne will see Ben take on the role of Chief Drill Adjudicator – a position he is eager to add to his portfolio of achievements.






