Chief Music Adjudicator Nigel Weeks



Nigel Weeks originates from Wales where he played trombone with the Tredegar Band. In 1979 he was appointed conductor of the Crosskeys Silver band taking them from 4th Section to Championship Section within four years. In 1986 he returned to Tredegar Town band directing both the Youth and Senior Bands. Both bands enjoyed a tremendous amount of contest successes winning many competitions, but in particular, the Youth band winning the European Youth Championships in 1993.

In 1994 Nigel came to New Zealand as Musical Director of the 'Dalewool Auckland Brass'. The band enjoyed a great period of great success with Nigel as its Musical Director, winning five New Zealand National Brass Band Championships and three Australian National Brass Band Championships. Nigel was the Musical Director of

the NZ National Youth Brass Band from 1998-2002 and also formed and directed the National Secondary Schools Brass Band, which now meets on an annual basis.

Nigel has been an examiner in brass for the Australian Music Examining Board (AMEB) and is currently an examiner for the newly formed NZ Examining Board (NZMEB). He studied conducting with Professor David King and holds an MA in performance and a Diploma in Teaching.

He has worked at Manurewa High School, where he formed a very successful SATB Choir and Concert Band programme and Kings College. In 2007 he became Head of the Music Faculty at Macleans College and since this time, music has gone from strength to strength with the emergence of a strong instrumental and choral programme. This was highlighted in 2010 and 2011 with the Orchestra, Concert Band, Chamber Orchestra all winning Gold Awards at the prestigious KBB Music Festival. In addition, all three groups (directed by Nigel) - Orchestra, Concert Band and Chamber Orchestra - all went on to win the 'Outstanding Award' in each of their respective categories. The Senior Concert Band also attended the NZ Concert Band Festival in New Plymouth and their performance in 2011, not only made it their fourth Gold Award in succession, but also resulted in them winning the prestigious 'Most Outstanding Performance Award' of the Festival. To date, the school has recorded two CDs which highlights the considerable musical talent at Macleans College.

Nigel is in constant demand within New Zealand, Australia and internationally as a band trainer and conductor. In 2009 he won 1st prize with the Gunnedah Shire Brass Band at the Australasian Open Entertainment Contest and in 2010 won the 'Test Piece' with North Shore Brass at the NZ National Brass Band Contest. He regularly adjudicates at competitions and festivals throughout the Southern Hemisphere.

Chief Music Adjudicator Dr Ralph Hultgren



Ralph Hultgren resides in Newmarket, Queensland, with his wife Julie. His professional music career has spanned a number of decades and includes work as a trumpet player, composer, conductor and teacher.

Dr Hultgren was, most recently, Head of Open Conservatorium at the Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University where he provided academic and artistic leadership to the Young Conservatorium, and conducted the Queensland Conservatorium Wind Orchestra, and lectured in conducting and instrumental music education at undergraduate and postgraduate levels.

Dr Hultgren's conducting credits include the direction of musicals, operettas, studio recordings for radio, television and disc, and the concert stage. He has premiered a number of his own works in Australian and internationally and conducted widely across Australia, the Asia Pacific region and the United States of America.

Dr Hultgren is a founding member of the Australian Band and Orchestra Directors' Association, and a member of the World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles. He has lead ABODA as national president and twice as state president and was awarded life

membership of ABODA in 1998. In 2000 he became the recipient of the Citation of Excellence, the Australian Band & Orchestra Directors' Association's highest honour. He is also the recipient of the 2005 Midwest Clinic International Award presented by the Board of Directors of the Midwest Clinic in recognition of his international contributions to music education. In 2009 Dr Hultgren was honoured by being made 'Patron of the Maryborough Music Conference', Australia's largest music education event. That honour is the most prestigious accolade given by Education Queensland for significant contributions to music education in the state.

Since commencing his composition life he has written works that span the broad spectrum of performance, from educational and amateur performing groups to the professional studio and stage. Outside of his musical endeavours, Mr Hultgren is an avid reader and the leader of his church Men's Fellowship.

Music Adjudicators



Edward Kennedy M.A. L.T.C.L. F.T.C.L. B.Teaching

Edward Kennedy was born in Belfast Northern Ireland and began playing the cornet and trumpet when he was twelve. He studied at the Belfast School of Music, where he attained advanced practical and theory examinations, including Trinity College London L.T.C.L. and F.T.C.L. Edward also studied music at Queensland University of Technology, The University of Southern Queensland and Salford University Manchester U.K.

He has conducted and played cornet with many bands in his career, including the Northern Ireland A Grade Champions 1st Old Boys Association, South Brisbane Federal Band, the Leyland Band, Hepworth Band, Mount Charles and YBS. Besides winning many cornet titles in Queensland over the last 20 years, Edward was also the winner of the prestigious title of the British Open Bb Cornet Champion of Great Britain in 2006 whilst he was studying conducting with professor David King. Over the last twenty eight years he has become highly respected throughout Australia as a successful music educator, trumpet and cornet player, conductor, adjudicator, clinician, composer and arranger.



Dr Peter Morris

Dr Peter Morris is the Director of Music at Villanova College in Brisbane, where he conducts ensembles, teaches trumpet, and administers a department with over 600 musicians, 30 performing ensembles and 25 full & part time staff. He is also the Artistic Director of the annual Queensland Catholic Colleges Music Festival hosted at Villanova College. He compliments his College teaching as the Lecturer in Undergraduate and Postgraduate Conducting at the Queensland Conservatorium, Griffith University, where he also conducts the Conservatorium Wind Orchestra.

Dr Morris is very active as a guest conductor, clinician and adjudicator in Queensland, across Australia and internationally. In recent years he has been the Music Director for World Youth Day, Brisbane (2008), and was a delegate for the recent National Review of School Music, commissioned by the Australian Music

Association. In July of 2011, he undertook major project entitled Ailan Kores (Island Chorus) for the Queensland Music Festival, conducting a concert of sacred choral and orchestral music on Thursday Island, including performances of Bach's St John's Passion and other major works translated into local dialects. A full-length documentary feature of this concert has been produced by the ABC, and has been broadcast on both national and international television. In the past two years, Peter enjoyed great opportunities to work with the Australian Band and Orchestra Directors Association (ABODA) across Australia. He was honoured to be the chief clinician of the ABODA Victoria Summer Conducting School in Melbourne, following in the shoes of American guru Craig Kirchoff. In July of 2012, he was a featured clinician at the ANBOC (Australian National Band and Orchestra Conference), and in January of 2013 and 2014, he ran the ABODA Western Australia summer conducting school.

Prior to immigrating to Australia in 2002, Peter performed in the US and internationally on trumpet in a wide variety of genres from Baroque orchestras to commercial session work in Los Angeles for film and TV. He has performed as a trumpeter backing such artists as Stevie Wonder and Paul Simon, and has performed for Australian touring shows in Asia. He has held university teaching positions in America at the University of California Los Angeles, the University of Houston and at Colorado State University.

Peter feels very privileged and humbled to be working in the field of music and education, and feels that he has the greatest job in the world!



Bryan Hurdley

In 1987 won a scholarship to the Birmingham Conservatorium where he studied trombone and euphonium with Denis Wick and Conducting with Adrian Leaper. He was the recipient of many performance awards and was the first brass player to be awarded distinction in teaching, performance and recital diplomas.

As a performer, Bryan has played with many of the UK's leading professional orchestras and has been Principle Euphonium with the Desford Band and the City of Coventry Band. In 1989 he was appointed Music Director of the Sunlife Band which was to be the beginning of a successful and distinguished conducting career that has seen him working with almost every leading band in the UK and Europe. Bryan has won every major band championship, either as a player or conductor and has been chief adjudicator at all the leading British and European band festivals.

In 2004 Bryan emigrated to Cairns, Australia to become Instrumental Coordinator at St Andrew's Catholic College. Together, with his wife Maureen Cameron, they have developed an outstanding reputation with award winning ensembles and students and nationally acclaimed educational programmes. 2009 saw the birth

of their daughter Catherine Elizabeth who takes up much of their energy but Bryan still finds time to continue his work as a guest conductor, clinician and adjudicator both in Australia and overseas.



Barrie Gott

Barrie Gott (b.1947), M.Mus. LTCL A.Mus.A, began his music career as a professional musician, studying trumpet with John Robertson and Harry Larsen at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music. He subsequently joined the National Training Orchestra and was a regular casual player with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra.

Barrie holds performance diplomas from the AMEB, Trinity College of Music, London in and a Masters degree in conducting from Azusa Pacific University in California where he studied with Dr. Gary Bonner. He has also studied composition and arranging at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music with Ross Edwards and Don Banks.

Barrie has taught at all levels of education in private and government sectors and was Director of Instrumental Music at Azusa Pacific University. He currently works for Education Queensland as a Senior Instrumental teacher and is a state examiner for the AMEB.

As a conductor Barrie has served as music director for Salvation Army bands in Sydney, Pasadena and Brisbane as well as the Brisbane Excelsior Band where he was successful in bringing a new dimension into concert programming. He is the former owner and musical director of the Queensland Pops Orchestra.

As a composer and arranger Barrie is published in Australia, United States, Great Britain and Europe and his works are on concert programs all over the world. He is a regular contributor to the Standard of Excellence repertoire for beginning concert bands in the education system.

Barrie is also an adjudicator for contests, festivals and eisteddfods throughout the world having officiated at regional, state and national contests in Australia and overseas in Norway and New Zealand.

Barrie was the recipient of the 2004 Frank Wright Medal for services to banding.



Venue Map


