

All winning bands in the Championship Section will receive a special trophy made available by Boosey & Hawkes and the Queensland Band Association Inc.

Perpetual trophies must be returned at the time specified by the N.B.C. **Solo Sections**

The first two placings in each section shall receive the appropriate medallion with the exception of the Champion of Champions sections where the winner will receive the N.B.C. Perpetual Trophy and the Boosey & Hawkes Medallion.

Each member and the conductor of a Quartette winning first or second place shall receive the appropriate medallion. The Band shall receive a suitable trophy.

The first three placings in all events shall receive the National Band Council Certificate.

BANDING IN QUEENSLAND

In the 1870's when the bands of England were forming what was known as the "National Association of Amateur Bands", the bands in Queensland Colony (as it was known then) had barely commenced. It would appear that the first contest held in Queensland was at the Brisbane Botanical Gardens in 1877. It was won on default by the Gympie Band which could have been a combination of the M.U.I.O.O.F. & G.U.I.O.O.F. Lodges. The Band travelled overland by horse and dray to Tewantin where it boarded the S.S. Noosa and then on to the contest. It was 20 years later that Queensland began to hold regular contests and in most contests bands were from the services such as the Artillery, Naval areas.

Little is known about our history in the period of 1877 - 1890 but private bands had sprung up with notables such as George Bloomfield who took a Naval band to Melbourne to appear at the formation of the Commonwealth celebrations. Other notables were Henry Grice of Brisbane, Messrs Snell and Percival of Gympie and Alf Hall of Maryborough. Mr Grice formed the Brisbane Municipal Concert Band which is still in existance.

Regular contests commenced at Toowoomba under the banner of the Austral Society and in 1906 there was a meeting of bands at Toowoomba which discussed the future of the movement and as a result the Queensland Band Association was formed and it has been the guiding force in banding now for the past 83 years. It took over the control of banding and the responsibility of organizing contests and these have now continued over those years with very little interruption.

Queensland had many notables in the early days, Chas Trussell was a great composer, arranger and conductor. There was Albert Wade, Bill Ryder (sen), Lou Gray, E. Jackson, W. Davis, Sam Whittaker, Jack Denovan, Albert Kaeser, Harold Perkins, Jimmy Clark, Horace Harper, Bill Bergemeister, Arthur Peek, Jim Napier, S. Ryan, Reg Dearlove, Jacky Brennan, Jock Henry, and so many others. In the middle era there were such names as Jim Compton, Digger Walmsley of Manly Concert band, G. Simpson, Billy Smith, Bill Ryder (jun) J.W. Gummow, Norman Henstridge, Len Crew that great trombonist and A.W. Trembath and into the fifties and sixties there was Les Baxter, Col Thomas and many others.

The Q.B.A. has had many able administrators and prominent among the early officers were Messrs A. Andrews, Cook, and Nicol both of whom were secretaries, Charlie Spargo, followed by Messrs Dunstan, Ryan as presidents, Will Jones, Len Seales.

George Cousins and Mr Caught held the position as president from 1928 - 37 and they took an active part in the formation of the Australian Band Council (now the N.B.C.). Charlie Green took over the presidency in 1937 and held it for over 30 years. Joe Foster was a long serving secretary and in that era we also had Col. Stan Cole, Tom Beatson and many others and these men, together with their team of amateur bandsmen, worked so hard to impart their knowledge to others so that the world might be a better place for their music and all of the time entertaining the public. And that tradition still continues.

In 1937 a contest was held in Brisbane and the prize money was 1,670 pounds, I will let the economists tell us what that amount would be today on current money values.. And so banding in Queensland is well and truly established and the movement continues to play an important part in the national life of the community.

Ralph Hultgren has been composing for over 20 years and has written for all levels and types of bands and orchestras, for radio and television, theatre and cabaret.


The bulk of his writing in recent years has been for young musicians and his committment to enable young Australians to play music by Australian Composers is well known.

On arriving at point AA Band will counter-march from front to rear to point BB, then counter-march from flank to flank and continue marching to point E, right turn and march to point FF, right wheel and march to point GG, halt and continue to play march to the end of strain. Any band Band will fall in, in marching formation at point AA and prepare to move off playing the Quickstep March and march to point DD. On arriving at point DD Band will counter-march from front to rear to point CC, then counter-march from flank to flank, right turn and march to point AA. halting before or moving past point GG will be penalised one point for each pace.

NOTE: When Band turns right to counter-march from flank to flank at point BB, Drum-Major and Drummers will turn left. When leading file is in line with left flank side-drummer, they will move off with Band and complete the diagram. Band means front rank.
