

# <u>Alan Morrison F.T.C.L., L.R.A.M.</u> <u>Senior Adjudicator</u>

Alan Morrison is principal solo cornet of the world famous Grimethorpe Colliery Band, a position he has held since 1980 from the age of 22.

Alan is the cornet tutor to the National Youth Brass Band of Great Britain. He was formerly the principal conet of this band and retired from the top chair after completing eleven courses at the compulsory retiring age of nineteen. He is also the cornet tutor to the National Youth Brass Band of Switzerland.




He has had a successful career as a conductor becoming one of Britain's youngest when he was appointed Musical Director of the Lingdale Band at the age of twenty. He has taken his bands to a number of contest wins.

Alan is in great demand as a soloist both in the United Kingdom and Europe as a band and solo tutor, and has produced a number of L.P. records and cassettes featuring himself as soloist. The last two of these, *Golden Classic for Cornet* and *Mark of a Champion*, both accompanied by the Grimethorpe Colliery Band, are a must for the library of every aspiring soloist. In addition, Alan has composed and arranged a number of pieces and solos for cornet and band.

Alan Morrison started learning to play the cornet at the age of seven and at the age of seventeen, while principal Solo Cornet with the Amoco Band, became Champion Soloist of Great Britain.

This is not the first trip to Australia for Alan. In 1978 he travelled to Queensland and won the Cornet and Champion of Champions

# Captain Ron Fawkes - Music Adjudicator



enlisted Fawkes Capt. Ron in the Australian Army as an apprentice musician in January 1970. Upon graduation he was awarded the Gullidge Memorial Medal as the most outstanding soldier/musician to graduate that year.

He was posted as a cornet player to the of the Royal Regiment Band of Australian Artillery, located at Singleton New South Wales, where he remained until the unit was disbanded in December 1973. His next posting was to

the North Queensland Army Band, located at Townsville. During his time in Townsville time he successfully completed his teaching diploma for the Trinity College of Music London (LTCL). In 1980 he returned to the Army School of Music to join the staff as a brass instuctor. After two years on the staff he was posted on promotion to Warrant Officer and served as the Band Sergeant Major of the Fifth Military District Band, Perth, the First Military District Band, Brisbane and the Second Military District Band, Sydney.

Capt. Fawkes was commissioned and appointed Music Director of the Band of the First Battalion, Royal Australian Regiment on January 27, 1987. He remained in Townsville for two years and during his time toured with the band extensively throughout the country regions of North Queensland.

On Januray 31, 1989 Capt. Fawkes took up his present appointment as Officer Commanding/Music Director of the Fourth Military District Band, Adelaide, South Australia.

# Ross A. Heinze - Senior Drill Adjudicator

Ross commenced banding activity in the percussion seciton of the Marananga Brass Band in the Baross Valley, South Australia in 1951. Due to emplyment he was transfered to Stawell Municipal Band ', Victoria in 1973 where he also played in the percussion section. Ross was appointed Drum Major of the Stawell Municipal Band in 1974.

# South Australia Bands Association - Adelaide, 27-31 March 1991

After returning to South Australia he rejoined the Marananga Brass Band where he currently serves as Drum Major after being appointed to that position in 1983. The band had considerable success in 1987 when it was judged the best marching band at the South Australian State Championships.

Ross was elected to the Executive Committee of the South Australian Band Association in 1982 and has served as President since 1985. He is also Chairman of the South Australian Band Association Drill Advisory Panel and a Registered Drill Adjudicator officiating at local competitions. He was appointed Drill Adjudicator at the 1988 Sydney National Band Championships.

Since 1984 Ross has been the South Australia National Band Council Delegate and a member of the Drill Panel which reviewed the drill and marching regulations and helped to develop the revised Drill and Marching manual.

# Greg Doyle - Assistant Drill Adjudicator

Greg is a current member of the Band Association of New South Wales and before his move to Batemans Bay in 1989, he was Vice-President of the Association, a member of the New South Wales Drill Advisory Board and represented NSW on the National Band Council.

In 1985 he led Willoughby Band to the first of three successive wins in the Quickstep/Display March at the National Championships. The third of these was capped by a win in the Street March contest. Willoughby has been awarded the trophy for Best Brass Band at the Sydney Anzac Day March and under his guidance as Drum Major has entertained spectators with marching displays at Sydney's Premiership Rugby League and A.F.L. matches.

Greg became a recognised Drill Adjudicator in 1986. A highlight since then was his inclusion on the shadow judging panel for the 1987 New Zealand Championships at the invitation of Chief Drill Judge, Tony Cowan, who conducted a Display March judging clinic as a lead up to the Contest. Other judging engagements include the New South Wales Marching Championships and the City of Paramatta Foundation Parade, each on three occasions, and the East Coast of Australia Display Marching Contest.

In February of this year, Greg was apointed Bandmaster of Moruya and District Brass Band, where he has been a playing member since taking up residence on the New South Wales south coast.

# Allan Tucker - Drill Adjudicator

Allan joined the Launceston Railway Silver Band in 1938, associated has been actively with the band and continuously as a player, Committeeman, Chairman (1968-73), Drum Major and Band Major (1980-85) - except for War Service with the R.A.A.F.

He was appointed Drum Major in 1954, a position he held until 1984 when severe ill health forced his retirement from full active participation with the band.

Allan was appointed a Drill Adjudicator in 1963 and has judged at many state titles, the last in 1990, as well as three National Championships. He also won the Bill Welling Shield on five occasions as best Drum Major at the state titles.

He is the present President of the Tasmanian Bands League and Chairman of the Organising Committee for the 1993 National Championship which will be held in Launceston.

Allan is a Life Member of the Tasmanian Bands League and Launceston Railway Silver Band and was awarded the Tasmanian Bands League Badge of Honour in 1984.

# Lance Little - Drill Adjudicator

Lance accepted his first appointment as Drum Major in 1945 and has been leading and instructing Brass and Pipe Bands since that year.

During the past twenty-five years, Lance has been Drum Major of the Ararat City Band and has led that band to many successes at National and State level, including the 1973 Nationals at Tanunda when he won the Most Efficient Drum Major title. As a Drill Adjudicator, he has officiated at many contests throughout Australia, including the Nationals of 1985 in Melbourne, 1986 in Adelaide, and in Launceston in 1987.

# Les Hample - Inspection Adjudicator

Les began banding with the Nuriootpa Primary School fife and drum band in year 5 and led the band as Drum Major in Year 7. He completed three months National Service training with the Army as an eighteen year old.

He began with the Nuriootpa Town Band as a trombone player in 1956. Several years later he lead the band as Drum Major when the band resumed competing at the Tanunda Band Championships after an absence of many years. The band has had many successes in Marching at these Competitions.


Les has adjudicated a variety of Marching Contest for the past twenty years and was Assisting Inspection Adjudicator at the 1986 National Contest held in Adelaide. He is a member of the South Australian Drill Advisory Panel and a recipient of the South Australia Band Association Badge of Merit.



# TROPHIES

The Championship Band in each grade will receive the appropriate National Band Council Perpetual Trophy plus the Boosey & Hawkes Championship Trophy. Second and Third placed bands in each section will also receive a trophy. In the Champion of Champions solo sections the winner will receive the appropriate National Band Council Perpetual Trophy plus a specially designed trophy and the Boosey & Hawkes Medallion if appropriate. The first three placings in all Solo sections will receive a specially designed medallion. An award will also be made for the Best Drum Major.

National Band Council Championship Certificates will be awarded to the first three placings on all events except Band Grade Championships and Solo Champion of Champions. In these events the Certificate will be awarded to First place only.





- 3. TIME LIMITS for OWN CHOICE SELECTIONS & HYMN:

- 4. All competitors are reminded to aquaint themselves with current Copyright laws before submitting their OWN CHOICE scores.
- 5. The championship in each grade shall be awarded to the band gaining the highest aggregate points for the TEST SELECTION and OWN CHOICE.

Trophies will be awarded as follows:

4 or more competitors	1st, 2nd, 3rd
3 competitors	1st, 2nd only
2 competitors	1st only

Champion Band shall receive the National Band Council perpetual trophy and the Boosey & Hawks trophy. All winning bands receive National Band Council Championship certificates. 6. In SOLO & QUARTET sections National Band Council Qualifying standards shall apply, i.e.

OPEN SECTIONS - EIGHTY-FIVE (85) points

JUNIOR SECTIONS - SEVENTY-EIGHT (78) points.

If in any section this standard is not reached, no award shall be given.

Trophies will be awarded as follows:

Trophey & MedallionCHAMPION SOLOISTSMedallionSECOND PLACETrophey & Special MedallionCHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS(JUNIOR & OPEN)

- Bands entering TWO (2) grades must play different OWN CHOICE SELECTIONS in each grade. Junior bands eligible to play in OPEN D GRADE may use the same OWN CHOICE SELECTION in BOTH grades. [N.B.C. rule 16 (f)]
- 8. In QUARTET sections each member of the party must be registered with the ONE (1) band, including the Conductor, and must wear the uniform of the band. Competitors in these sections will be allowed the services of their Bandmaster, or another registered member of the band as conductor. [N.B.C. rule 23]
- 9. Any entrant competing in a JUNIOR SECTION shall not have attained the age of NINETEEN (19) years at the date of the competition. Birth Certificate or other means of proof of age may be required. [N.B.C. rule 3 (b)]


# MARCHING RULES & REGULATIONS OVAL MARCHING CONTEST

(Compulsory for all Senior Brass Grades)

1. The Marching Contest will be an "OVAL MARCH" as described in clause 3, page 3 GENERAL MARCHING REGULATIONS of the

National Band Council DRILL & MARCHING REGULATIONS 1988.

- 2. The first element, SET DIAGRAM, will be DIAGRAM No 8, page 42 of the DRILL & MARCHING REGULATIONS 1988.
- The second element will be an "OWN CHOICE DISPLAY" of minimum of THREE (3) minutes and maximum of SIX (6) minutes, as set out in "OWN CHOICE DISPLAY MARCHING REGULATIONS", pages 8-9 of National Band Council DRILL & MARCHING REGULATIONS 1988.
- 4. The area will be EIGHTY (80) metres by FIFTY (50) metres.
- On receipt of entry all bands will be forwarded a complete list of all (if any) amendments made to the DRILL & MARCHING REGULATIONS 1989 by the 1990 Conference of the National Band Council Delegates.
- 6. INSPECTION: inspection will be carried out in "MARCHING FORMAITON" immediately prior to the band competing in the "OVAL MARCH" competition.


