



Chief Music Adjudicator Garry E. Cutt

Since graduating in the early 1980's, Garry Cutt has developed a reputation as one of the banding worlds most respected and successful conductors.

His 17 year relationship with the Marple Band resulted in many of Garry's early contest success: A hat-trick of 4th prizes during 1992/3/4 and their British Open victory of 1996 are some of the most remarkable results in the history of the contest. This was Garry's second "Open" title, having previously guided the Kennedy's Swinton Band to their 1989 win and at the same time, becoming the youngest winning conductor in the competition's history and the very first recipient of The Mortimer Maestro Award.



Garry was appointed Musical Director to the Grimethorpe Colliery Band in 1991, a position he held for twelve years. The phenomenal impact of the film "Brassed-Off" resulted in Garry leading the band on sell-out tours, notably Australia on three occasions and performing in that iconic building, Sydney Opera House. Other overseas trips have included Japan, New Zealand, and Hong Kong. April 2003 saw the band and conductor, making their debut in New York's Carnegie Hall! He has an enviable reputation on the concert platform, cemented by six victories at Spennymoor's Brass in Concert.

In September 2003, Garry was awarded the Iles Medal by The Worshipful Company of Musicians in recognition of his services to the Brass Band Movement.

September of 2004 witnessed the history books of The Fodens Richardson Band being dramatically re-written. For the band after several near misses, their 1st British Open victory since 1964, for Garry, his third Mortimer Maestro award! He was delighted to be appointment the Band's Professional Conductor in January 2005.

Garry continues to be Associate Conductor of The National Youth Brass Band of Great Britain, working closely with Elgar Howarth, something of which he is very proud.

Assistant Chief Music Adjudicator Bryan Hurdley BA (Hon) LRAM. ABSM.

Bryan Hurdley was born in Ironbridge, Shropshire, England and started playing the Euphonium in the school band at Abraham Darby when he was 11. In 1985 he won a scholarship to the Birmingham Conservatoire where he studied Trombone and Euphonium with Dennis Wick and Conducting with Adrian Leaper. Bryan is the only brass player to be awarded distinction in teaching, performing and recital diplomas at the Conservatoire as well as the Birmingham Midland Institute Prize, Rollinson and Doris Newton Prizes and the coveted Concerto prize.

A founder member of the English Tuba Consort, Bryan has travelled widely. As a conductor, adjudicator and clinician, he has worked in almost every European country, Scandinavia, the USA, Australia and New Zealand. He has an impressive list of recordings for radio and television, numerous CD's to his credit and, as a tenor tuba player, has worked with many of the UK's finest orchestras including the Philharmonia, the Royal Philharmonic and the City of Birmingham Symphony Orchestras.

Over recent years, Bryan has enjoyed an increasing reputation as one of the finest conductors and band trainers of his generation with a particular specialty in the contemporary repertoire. He has held with distinction, the post of Music Director of the Williams Fairey Band, the Sunlife Band and the Fodens Band and his work with the Mount Charles Youth and Senior bands is well recognized. As guest conductor, famous names such as Black Dyke, Grimethorpe, Desford, Wingates, and Newtongrange from the UK, Stavanger Brass, Sandifjord Brass Symposium from Norway and the Brass Band Berner Oberland from Switzerland are regular associations.

In April 2005 Bryan accepted an invitation to become part of the music programme at St Andrews Catholic College in Cairns, Australia where he currently resides.

Assistant Chief Music Adjudicator Simone Rebello

Simone Rebello graduated from the Royal Northern College of Music with Distinction and a collection of awards including a major scholarship and The Phillip Jones Prize. She began a solo career which has taken her around the world with concerto appearances, solo recitals, master classes and appearances on national and international TV and radio. She has recorded several CDs and is in high demand as a soloist with brass bands, wind ensembles and symphony orchestras. She continues to win awards such as the 1998 Cosmopolitan/House of Fraser Woman of the Year in the Arts.



Simone regularly performs with the internationally renowned BackBeat Percussion Quartet of which she is a founder member. The group tours extensively in Japan and America and has also given concerts in Zimbabwe, the Cayman Islands and throughout Europe. In addition to recording two CDs and numerous international TV and radio broadcasts, the group has won several competitions including the Royal Overseas League Ensemble Prize (1997), The Osaka International Chamber Music Fiesta (1999) and The USA Concert Artists Guild (2001) which led to a USA debut at The Weill Hall—Carnegie Hall. The group has commissioned several new works and its 2002 Proms debut was broadcast live on BBC television.

In 1997 Simone formed Equivox with leading saxophonist Rob Buckland and this contemporary music group record and perform internationally. They have commissioned several new works and are releasing their latest CD in 2005. Simone collaborates with various musicians on projects and continues to work as a solo recitalist with pianist/organist Julian Wilkins.

Simone devises and presents concerts and workshops to children of all ages and works annually with Young World UK who produces concerts featuring large choirs (up to 8000 children) in UK arenas including the Manchester Evening News Arena. She is frequently asked to adjudicate at national and international brass and wind band competitions, percussion festivals and events for BBC Radio, and speaks regularly at events concerning performance skills, the development of concerts and workshops for children and general percussion topics.

Simone Rebello is a solo artist and endorsee for Yamaha-Kemble UK. Her attendance at the 2006 National Championships as an adjudicator and guest artist at the Gala Concert were made possible with the support of Yamaha Music Australia.

Assistant Chief Music Adjudicator Philip Davis GCHE

Philip Davis is Head of Performance Music and Brass tutor at Redlands College; teaches part time at The University of Queensland and is an AMEB examiner in brass.



He is also musical advisor and guest conductor for Dunman High School and Yio Chu Symphonic Band and other ensembles in Singapore and Musical Director of Queensland Symphonic Winds and a freelance musician.


In 2002, he became the music director and conductor of Brisbane Philharmonic Orchestra which recently performed at "Jimbour" in the Queensland Music Festival and in the Brisbane City Hall with Opera Queensland Young Artists, the Brisbane Choral and didgeridoo soloist William Barton.

Phillip's playing career spans over 35 years during which time he was a professional trombonist with the Elizabethan Melbourne Orchestra, ABC Orchestra, Queensland Philharmonic and other orchestras throughout Australia. He has taught, conducted, played in many universities, schools, community groups, concert and brass bands, ensembles, commercial work and has toured to South East Asia on five occasions as the musical director of the Queensland Symphonic Winds.

Mr. Davis has frequently adjudicated for state and national championships, competitions, eisteddfodau and festivals. His personal interests other than music include reading, walking and travel.

Chief Drill Judge Paul Sullivan

Paul Sullivan began his band career in 1974 as a cornet player with the 25th Battalion Band based in Toowoomba. In 1987 he joined the 2/14 Lighthorse Regiment (Queensland Mounted Infantry) Band where he has played both Tenor Horn and Baritone. Paul was trained as a Drum Major at the Army School of Music, Melbourne, and became Drum Major of 2/14 LHR Band in 1988. Under his leadership the band has won numerous diagram and street marching events at District, State and National competitions. In 1998 he was awarded 'Champion Drum Major' at the Queensland State Band Championships. That same year Paul was appointed as a Queensland Drill Adjudicator. Since then Paul has adjudicated at both district and state levels.
