

Chief Adjudicators

Chief Music Adjudicator – Brass Bands

Ken MacDonald, BA (Mus.), Grad. Dip. Ed



Ken MacDonald was one of those fortunate people to be born into a musical family, and to grow up in an atmosphere where music was part of daily life. He was born in Sunderland, England, at the end of the Second World War. Even though Ken has studied and played under many famous musicians, he firmly believes that he owes most of his success to his father, Stanley, who taught and encouraged him as a young boy. Stan (who has since passed away) conducted many Brass Bands, composed and arranged and concentrated a lot of time to the development of younger players, his involvement spanned over seventy fruitful years. At the age of 11 Ken started his playing career, and over the next 5 years gained many honours in Solo Competitions, including a hat trick of wins at the Northern England Championships.

He was accepted into the National Youth Orchestra and Youth Brass Band of Great Britain after a series of auditions at the age of 14. In 1966 he was approached by Harry Mortimer to join one of his "MEN OF BRASS" Bands, Morris Motors, this was the beginning of his association with England's Top Bands.

The following year Ken took up his first teaching post in Barnsley, Yorkshire and joined the world famous Grimethorpe Colliery Band as Assistant Principal Cornet and was soon promoted to Principal Cornet. In 1974 Ken made another career move, to the renowned Black Dyke Mills Band. The following 9 years proved even more successful in many areas: Contests, cutting numerous records, making many Television and Radio appearances, and playing an average 80/100 concerts per year.

Since his arrival in Australia in 1983, Ken has played a significant part in the development of Concert and Brass Bands throughout Australia, imaginative concerts, the production of many compact discs and an enviable record of Competition successes. He has adjudicated throughout Australia, America and New Zealand, made many guest appearances (playing and conducting) and conducted seminars and workshops for Boosey & Hawkes and Yamaha. He retired from serious playing to take up the position of Musical Director with Hawthorn City Band in 1985, leading them to 5 National Championships and many State and overseas titles, as well as tours to America and New Zealand. He took over the leadership of Footscray-Yarraville City Band in 1998 and very quickly built them up to be one of the finest in the Country.

Chief Music Adjudicator – Concert Bands

Maj. Graham Lloyd, M.Mus. (Melb.), ARCM, LTCL, A.Mus.A



Major Graham Lloyd enlisted into the Australian Regular Army in 1972 as an Apprentice Musician studying the clarinet. Upon graduation he received the Boosey and Hawkes prize for instrumental proficiency, and was posted to the 4th Military District Band in Adelaide, South Australia.

In 1976 he was detached to the Army School of Music, Balcombe, Victoria, as a clarinet and theory instructor. The same year, he was posted to the Band of the First Recruit Training Battalion at Wagga Wagga, New South Wales, followed in 1977 by a further posting to the Army School of Music as an instructor where he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and later Staff Sergeant.

In 1982, he began his Student Bandmaster Course at the Royal Military School of Music Kneller Hall, Twickenham, London. He received: the Besson Cup and Medal for gaining the highest marks in the Ministry of Defence Examinations; the Somerville Prize for best concert band arrangement; and the coveted Worshipful Company of Musicians Trophy and Silver Medal for the best overall student of the course.

Upon his return to Australia in 1985, he was promoted to Lieutenant and appointed as the Second in Command/Deputy Music Director of the Band of the 5th Military District, Perth. In 1987, he was posted to the Defence Force School of Music in Macleod, Victoria, and promoted to Captain. In 1989, Graham was posted as the Second in Command/Deputy Music Director of the 3rd Military District Band in Melbourne, Victoria.

He then accepted the position of Director of Music, Royal Australian Air Force (RAAF) and Commanding Officer of the then RAAF Central Band and was promoted to Squadron Leader. In 1997, he was appointed as the Commanding Officer of the Air Force Band. Following a further restructure in 2000, which saw a reversion back to separate bands, he was posted to RAAF Training Command, Laverton, in charge of Air Force music policy and the direction of Air Force bands.

In Feb 2004, Graham accepted the position of Officer Commanding/Chief Instructor at the Defence Force School of Music and subsequently transferred back to the Army.

Graham's main interests are conducting, composing, arranging and teaching. His Concert Band work, *Prelude for a Festival*, won the 1988 Yamaha Composer of the Year award. Additionally, he has arranged and composed over 400 works for Concert Bands, Brass Bands and orchestras for every possible occasion from major concerts in the Opera House to the Edinburgh Military Tattoo in Sydney in 2005. He completed his Masters in music composition at Melbourne University in 1999 studying with Professor Brenton Broadstock.

As a conductor, major highlights include: the 70 piece United States Air Force Band in Washington D.C. in 199, conducting the RAAF Band at the 1995 Royal Tournament in London, and conductor of the Federation Bells and Brass Concert at the Sidney Myer Music Bowl, Melbourne 2001, which featured over 500 performers and was the final concert for the Melbourne International Music Festival celebrating 100 years since Federation.

The Alfred Arthur Thomas Trust

The Nationals Committee of the Victorian Bands' League acknowledges a significant donation towards the cost of running the 2007 Australian National Band Championships from the Arthur Alfred Thomas Trust. The Trust is currently administered by the Equity Trustees Ltd.

The story of the Trust begins with the arrival in South Australia in 1844 of William Charles Thomas, at the age of seven years. He eventually founded a flour milling "empire", with its first mill being built in Lawrence Street, Beaufort, Victoria in 1870. Over the whole of its existence of 107 years the W.C. Thomas and Sons Pty Ltd flour milling company had operated ten mills across the Wimmera, (but not all at the one time). Thomas had one daughter and four sons, one of his sons being Arthur Alfred, who was born in Beaufort. Arthur and his three brothers were active in their father's business, and their sons in turn eventually also became involved.

W.C. Thomas was a civic minded man, who treated his staff very well. He was a staunch Primitive Methodist, was a councillor of the Shire of Ripon for 12 years, and Shire President for two years. He died at the age of 82.

Arthur Thomas evidently inherited the good qualities of his father, for later in life he was an outstanding citizen of Essendon, being a City of Essendon councillor for 11 years, and Mayor between 1925 and 1927. He was married later in life (1928), at the age of 59, to Ivy Hamilton Schofield. They had no children. In 1935 he was elected to the Melbourne City Council, but eventually resigned due to ill health.

Like his father, he was a staunch Methodist, and was described as being of a charitable disposition, broad understanding, a great friend to many, and helpful to many whose need was brought under his notice. He was a Masonic Lodge member also.

He died on 20th April 1944 at his home at 36 Leslie Street Essendon. His will showed that he left an estate of some £110,000. As he had no children, after he had made provision for his wife, nephews and nieces and some friends, he left the bulk of his estate in a charitable trust. He provided that the available income of the trust should be distributed around September each year to charity (in the widest sense).

Arthur did have a musical interest, having been the organist at the Beaufort Methodist church, and his brother, William Charles Frederick Thomas married Georgina Harriet Heathershaw, of Caslemaine, daughter of the local minister, with Arthur as his best man. Miss Heathershaw had studied piano, and some years earlier gave private lessons at the Thomas residence in Beaufort. We cannot say that these family musical interests have given rise directly to the donation we have received, but they may help us believe that we are a fitting recipient.

Once again, we thank the Trustees of the Arthur Alfred Thomas Trust for their generosity.

I also thank Pam Weller, Secretary/Research Officer of the Beaufort Historical Society, and Lenore Frost, President of the Essendon Historical Society for supplying information on which this brief summary is based. Information was also obtained from the Wills and Probate archive of the Victorian Public Records Office.

The Fireman's Helmet

The first Melbourne Fire Brigade (MFB) Band existed from 1900 to 1950, and won the Australian National Championship four times. It was never defeated in a marching competition. It was disbanded (no pun intended!) in 1950 whilst it was still the Australian Champion band.

In its second existence from 1965 to 1970 the Band under Mervyn Simpson won six contests including two Australian Championships (1968 and 1970). History repeated itself, when in November 1970, the Melbourne Fire Brigades' Board decided not to continue its support for the Band, which consequently disbanded again. The Band therefore has the dubious honour of being the only one disbanded twice whilst holding the Australian 'A' Grade Championship! Alan Ball was a BBb bass player with the Band. With some eleven other members he followed Bandmaster Mervyn Simpson to Footscray City Band in 1971.

In 1972 Alan donated his brass fireman's helmet, and MFB Superintendent Jack McKimm, who was also Manager and Deputy Conductor of the band, organized its being mounted as a trophy. While it was not openly stated, the connotation was that the trophy was a memorial to the Melbourne Fire Brigade Band.

It was therefore fitting that Footscray City Band, under the baton of Mervyn Simpson, former Bandmaster of the Melbourne Fire Brigade Band, won the trophy in the three following consecutive years of 1972, 1973 and 1974.

Names of players from the MFB Band who went to, or played with, Footscray-Yarraville include: Jack McKimm (cornet), Merv Cavell (cornet), Arthur Withers (cornet), Henry Bowyer (cornet), Alan McKimm (cornet and flugel horn), Doug Trottnan (tenor horn), Ian Fowler (tenor horn), Claude Scanlon (baritone), Bill Wheatley (euphonium), Charlie Ring (trombone), Laurie Lavelle (Eb bass), Albert Hathaway (Eb bass), Alan Ball (BBb bass), Arthur Fenton (percussion).
